

Summer 2021 Registration Schedule

Summer Registration starts March 15, 2021. Eligible students may register on *ASAP* (asap.utsa.edu) as listed below.

* Priority registration will be granted for all [eligible veterans and service members](#) who are currently utilizing GI Bill benefits.

Registration Instructions

1. Review the registration chart to find your designated registration start date and time.

Registration timeframes are based on student classification (your total earned credit hours).

- Each timeframe has a start date/time when students in that classification can register before registration opens for the next classification.

2. Prepare ahead of time prior to registration.

- **Check your registration status** → Log into [ASAP](#) to check your current classification and earned credit hours (*click on "Student Services", then "Registration", then "Select Term", then "Check Registration Status", then look under "Earned Credit" and add "transfer hours" and "institutional hours" to get your total earned credit hours*)
- **Check your holds and prerequisites** → Certain holds and prerequisites can prevent registration, so it is highly recommended that students address any holds or prerequisite overrides they have or need prior to their registration timeframe.

3. Register.

- **Login to ASAP** → Students must log onto their ASAP student portal to register for, add, or drop up to 15 semester credit hours during the entire summer semester (regardless of the combination of terms). Please note students on probation or academic warning are limited to 7 credit hours during the entire summer semester and students on probation may not enroll in a course offered in a term of less than five weeks.

During the summer semester, a student may enroll in no more than 3 credit hours in a 3-week term, no more than 4 credit hours in a 4-week term, no more than 6 credit hours in a 5-week term, no more than 9 credit hours in an 8-week term, and no more than 12 credit hours in a 10-week term.

- Waitlists will be open for the 10-week, 8-week, 5-week, and 4-week terms.

Additionally, please note classroom (location) assignments will not be available during registration. Classrooms are assigned approximately two weeks before the scheduled start of the semester. Lastly, this registration schedule is subject to change.
