Confirmed Cases Reported to UTSA

The health and safety of our Roadrunners is paramount. UTSA is closely monitoring active cases on campus to determine the impact on our campus community and to minimize the spread of COVID-19 as much as possible.

In an effort to keep the Roadrunner community informed about the presence of COVID-19 positive cases **on campus**, UTSA will provide regular updates regarding the number of positive cases with direct campus impact and the number of students quarantined in student housing.

Tables show cumulative data since August 24, 2020 (the first day of the fall semester). Data is updated by 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and reflects information as of the day before.

Definitions:

- **Athletic Cohort:** Students and staff tested on a regular basis as part of NCAA guidelines and internal protocols.
- **Direct Campus Impact:** Individuals who have received a positive COVID-19 test and: (a) live in Laurel or Chaparral Village, (b) are part of the Athletic cohort, (c) whose work or study modality is "on-campus," or (d) have been on campus and had a close contact* with a student, staff, or faculty member.
- **Faculty/Staff:** Individuals employed by the university. Data for students employed in some capacity by UTSA is reflected in the student sections of this dashboard.
- **Isolation:** UTSA Housing residents who test positive for COVID-19 must isolate from roommates for 10 days.
- **Positive:** Individuals who received a positive COVID-19 test result.
- **Positivity Rate:** The number of positive tests divided by the total number of tests (positive and negative).
- **Proactive Testing:** Students who participate in the voluntary [proactive testing program](#).
- **Quarantine:** UTSA Housing residents who are exposed to a COVID-19 positive person and have not tested positive for COVID-19, must quarantine for 14 days.
- **Symptomatic Testing:** Individuals who are tested because they experience COVID-19 symptoms or because they were exposed to an individual who tested positive for COVID-19.
- **Students:** Students enrolled for the current semester.
- **Weekly Change:** Percent change in positivity rate over the last 7-day reporting period. This number is updated weekly on Fridays and reflects the percent change in positivity rate from the previous week. The COVID-19 positivity rate for the City of San Antonio is updated daily on the [San Antonio Metro Health website](#).

*Close contact is defined by the CDC as someone who was within 6 feet of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period starting from 2 days before illness onset (or, for asymptomatic patients, 2 days prior to test specimen collection) until the time the patient is isolated.

UTSA is committed to protecting the personal health information of our community. All information shared adheres to privacy standards. Data for this website is compiled from Student Health Services, Occupational Health, Athletics, Housing and Residence Life and from [self-reporting](#). Positive case data is also shared with the San Antonio Metropolitan Health Department. Since some of the information is [self-reported](#), confirmation of the results of each test cannot be definitively verified.
