2014: NTT Committee conducts focus groups of FTT Faculty

2015: Prepares white paper "Moving Towards One Faculty at UTSA"

2016-2018: Continues to identify issues experienced by NTT faculty

2018: NTT Committee updates white paper and meets with Dr. Espy.

2018-19: Committee examines policies and procedures related to NTT faculty at our aspirant institutions, other UT System institutions and other colleges in San Antonio

2019: NTT committee was charged with drafting revised policies and guidelines for NTT Faculty in conjunction with Academic Affairs

2019: Dr. Shipley sets up NTT Titles and Promotion Working Group

2020 Recommended changes to HOP

HOP 2.02 Faculty Appointments and Titles

HOP 2.50 Fixed-Term-Track Faculty Recruitment, Evaluation, and Promotion Processes

Working Group prepared a Transition Plan

Also prepared Guidelines for Promotion

HOP changes were adopted in November 2020

• NTT faculty are now called FTT faculty

• New titles include Professor of Instruction series

• New university-wide process for promotion in place, with packets to be submitted on Jan 31 each year for review during spring semester

After first round of promotion

Fall 2021: Almost all FTT faculty got new titles and 120 FTT faculty were promoted

2021/22: FTT Task Force conduct more focus groups. FTT faculty expressed some gratitude for new titles etc., but also confusion about the promotion process

Fall 2022: 80 more FTT faculty were promoted

2022 Focus Group report submitted to AA

Fall 2022: Working Group was reconvened to recommend some clarifications and small changes to HOP 2.02 and 2.50.

Fall 2022: Dr. Shipley and FTT Task Force hold two workshops for promotion-eligible FTT faculty

March 2023: Additional updates to HOP 2.02 and 2.50 were approved and adopted.

Some of the modifications

• Senior Lecturers can be part- or full-time

• There will be college level committees (CRC) for promotion review

 Colleges can set eligibility time-frames for promotion of part-time FTT faculty

Summary

• This has been a 10-year process

• There has been in-put from many stake holders

• On-going efforts for additional clarification, and to provide peer mentoring and info sessions on how to prepare promotion packets, grant proposals etc.
