

Behavioral intervention team (BIT)

- A multi-disciplinary group
 - meets regularly to support students, employees, faculty, staff.
- The team tracks concerning behavior - “red flags”
 - detects patterns, trends, and disturbances in individual or group behavior based on reports of disruptive, problematic, or concerning behavior or misconduct.
