The Faculty Senate University Curriculum Committee (UCC) allowed the proposers to revise their proposals to address CCC concerns. Then, UCC reviewed the original submissions, the reviews/recommendations of CCC, and the revised proposals (all the original and revised proposals and CCC reviews/recommendations are available in a shared folder for Senate).

In general, UCC agreed with CCC on CS 1713 and PAD 1113; and approved both CS 1713 and PAD 1113. CCC had rejected the original submission of ENG 2442. However, majority of UCC members found that the <u>revised</u> ENG 2442 proposal has satisfactorily addressed the concerns; thus, approved ENG 2442 as well. The details of UCC votes are given in the below table.
