- Summary of Changes Update to reflect change to HOP 2.01
 The Faculty: Role in Educational Policy Formulation removal of the role of Secretary of the General Faculty
- Add School Directors alongside Department Chairs throughout By-laws to reflect current titles
- Add FTT faculty titles throughout By-laws to reflect current titles
- Article II Membership
 - Clarified terms of office in the event a senator cannot fulfill their three year term when the remaining term is one year or less—will not count toward the two- three year terms.



- Officer Roles Article III
 - Chair term will change from two years to four years
 - 1st year Vice Chair/Chair Elect
 - 2nd and 3rd year Chair
 - 4th year Past Chair
 - Secretary term will change from one year to three years; will remain a ex-officio voting member. Academic Unit will be asked to elect an alternate for remainder of his/her term as Faculty Senator and will serve as a voting member.
 - Parliamentarian term will change from one year to two years; will remain a voting member and representative of his/her academic unit.



- Roles of Officers Article III
 - More clearly defined. Added a nominating committee appointed by the Secretary to identify and prepare slate of nominees for Chair.
- Secretary is taking on more prominent role in the Faculty Senate and will represent the Faculty Senate as a member of the UT System Faculty Advisory Council.



- Article V
 - No major changes—clarified voting procedures since meetings are conducted online
- Article VIII Committees
 - Recommendation FTT's select a member among the college FTT representatives to serve on the FS Executive Committee
- Article IX Faculty Senate Panels
 - Update based on HOP policies and VP Research (HOP 10.02)
