Karen Collins, Compensation Analysts HR- Fair Labor Standard Act (FSLA) Changes Effective Jan. 1, 2020, a final ruling has changed the weekly minimum salary threshold that determines if positions will be exempt or non-exempt from FLSA's overtime requirements. The minimum salary threshold has increased from \$455 per week (\$23,660 annually) to \$684 weekly (\$35,658 annually). Employees affected by this change were sent letters.

Minimum hourly wages were also raised to \$14 per hour back in September 2019. This compressed several salary grades into fewer levels. Funding to address the compression is being looked at, since the changes meant some newer employees are now making close to what longer-serving employees are making.
