





University of Central Florida Under-represented Minority Enrollment by Ethnicity




Percent of Full-time, First-time Degree-seeking Undergraduates who were awarded Title IV Federal Student Aid by Income Level







University of Central Florida One-year Retention Rates








University of Central Florida Six-Year Graduation Rates By Ethnicity














University of Central Florida Headcount by Tenure Status




University of Central Florida Percent of Faculty by Tenure Status




University of Central Florida Under-represented Minority (URM) Faculty




University of Central Florida Under-represented Minority Faculty by Tenure Status



University of Central Florida Faculty by Gender




University of Central Florida Female Faculty by Tenure Status






University of Central Florida Staff by Ethnicity





University of Central Florida Total Research Expenditures




University of Central Florida Federally Financed Research Expenditures






University of Central Florida Total Revenue per FTE Student




University of Central Florida Tuition and fees per FTE Student




University of Central Florida State Appropriations per FTE Student



University of Central Florida Expense Type as a Percent of Core Expenses




University of Central Florida Administrative Cost as a Percent of Instructional Cost
