




University of California-Santa Cruz Enrollment

University of California-Santa Cruz Under-represented Minority Enrollment by Ethnicity




Percent of Full-time, First-time Degree-seeking Undergraduates who were awarded Title IV Federal Student Aid by Income Level







University of California-Santa Cruz One-year Retention Rates








University of California-Santa Cruz Six-Year Graduation Rates By Ethnicity














University of California-Santa Cruz Headcount by Tenure Status




University of California-Santa Cruz Percent of Faculty by Tenure Status




University of California-Santa Cruz Under-represented Minority (URM) Faculty




University of California-Santa Cruz Under-represented Minority Faculty by Tenure Status












University of California-Santa Cruz Staff by Gender





University of California-Santa Cruz Total Research Expenditures




University of California-Santa Cruz Federally Financed Research Expenditures






University of California-Santa Cruz Total Revenue per FTE Student




University of California-Santa Cruz Tuition and fees per FTE Student




University of California-Santa Cruz State Appropriations per FTE Student



University of California-Santa Cruz Expense Type as a Percent of Core Expenses




University of California-Santa Cruz Administrative Cost as a Percent of Instructional Cost
