








University of Maryland-Baltimore County Under-represented Minority (URM) Enrollment



University of Maryland-Baltimore County Under-represented Minority Enrollment by Ethnicity




Percent of Full-time, First-time Degree-seeking Undergraduates who were awarded Title IV Federal Student Aid by Income Level







University of Maryland-Baltimore County One-year Retention Rates








University of Maryland-Baltimore County Six-Year Graduation Rates By Ethnicity








University of Maryland-Baltimore County Grant Aid All Sources









University of Maryland-Baltimore County Headcount by Tenure Status



University of Maryland-Baltimore County Percent of Faculty by Tenure Status





University of Maryland-Baltimore County Under-represented Minority Faculty by Tenure Status




University of Maryland-Baltimore County Faculty by Gender






University of Maryland-Baltimore County Student-to-Faculty Ratio








University of Maryland-Baltimore County Staff by Ethnicity




University of Maryland-Baltimore County Staff by Gender








University of Maryland-Baltimore County Total Research Expenditures




University of Maryland-Baltimore County Federally Financed Research Expenditures






University of Maryland-Baltimore County Total Revenue per FTE Student




University of Maryland-Baltimore County Tuition and fees per FTE Student




University of Maryland-Baltimore County State Appropriations per FTE Student



University of Maryland-Baltimore County Expense Type as a Percent of Core Expenses




University of Maryland-Baltimore County Administrative Cost as a Percent of Instructional Cost
