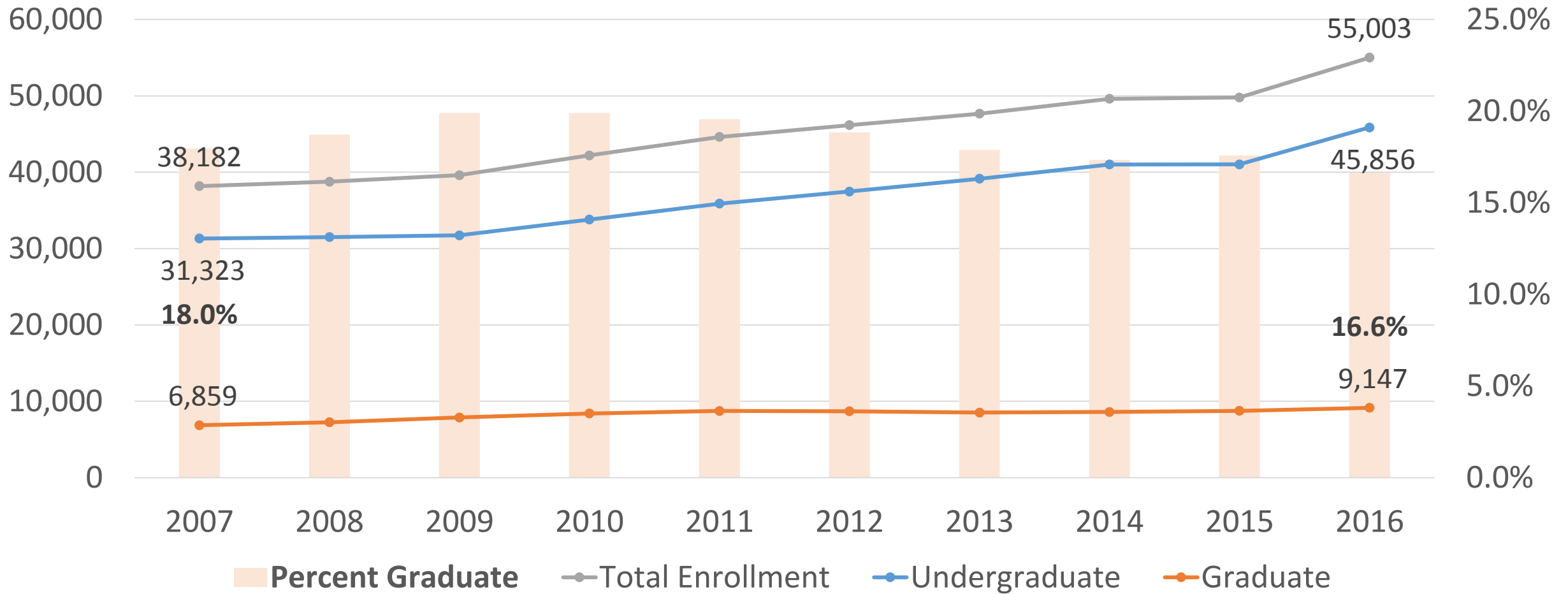
Recent Recognition

- **Ranked 46th on the Social Mobility Index created by CollegeNET, a higher education technology firm, and Payscale, which tracks worker pay**

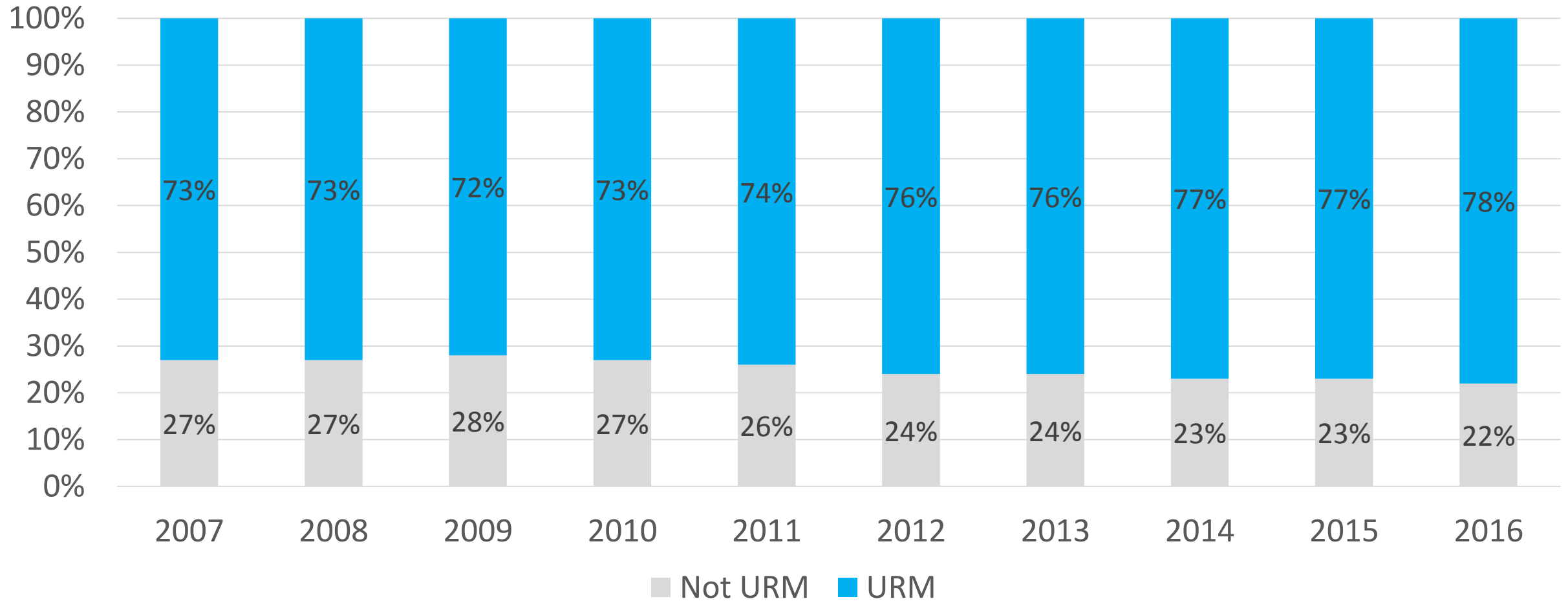

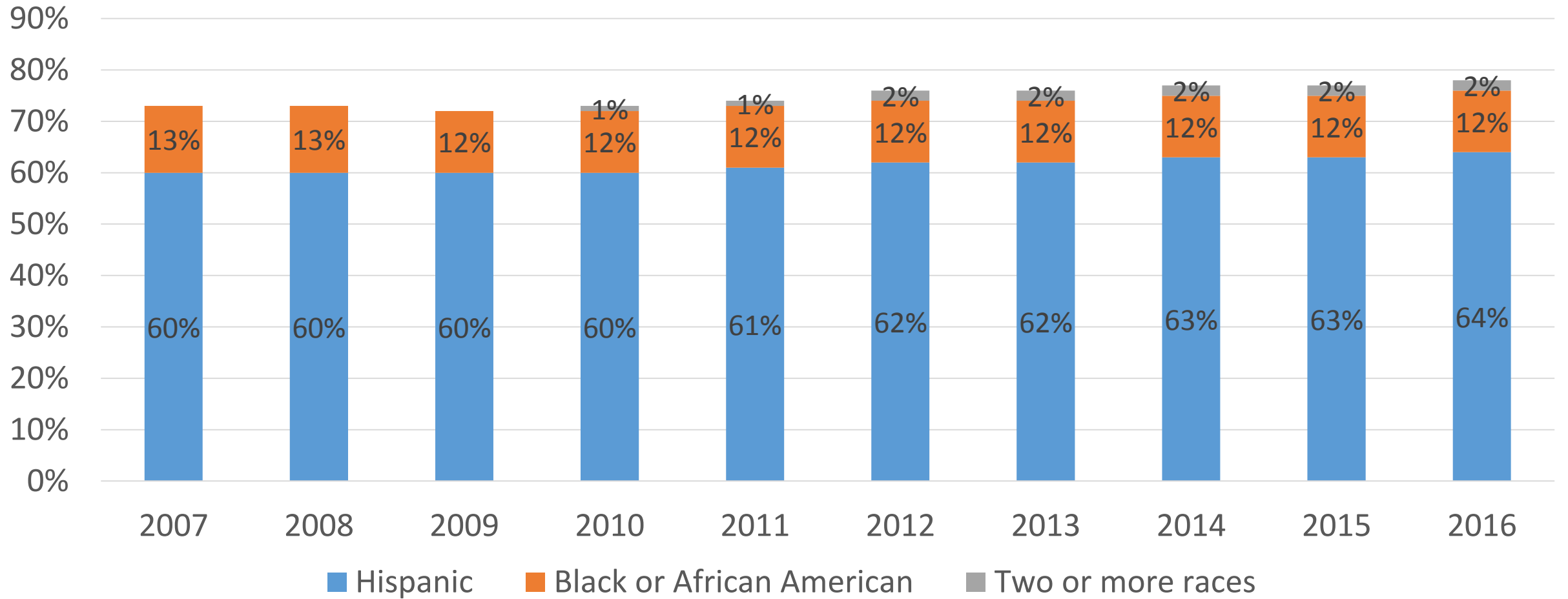


Florida International University Under-represented Minority (URM) Enrollment

Under-represented Minority Enrollment by Ethnicity

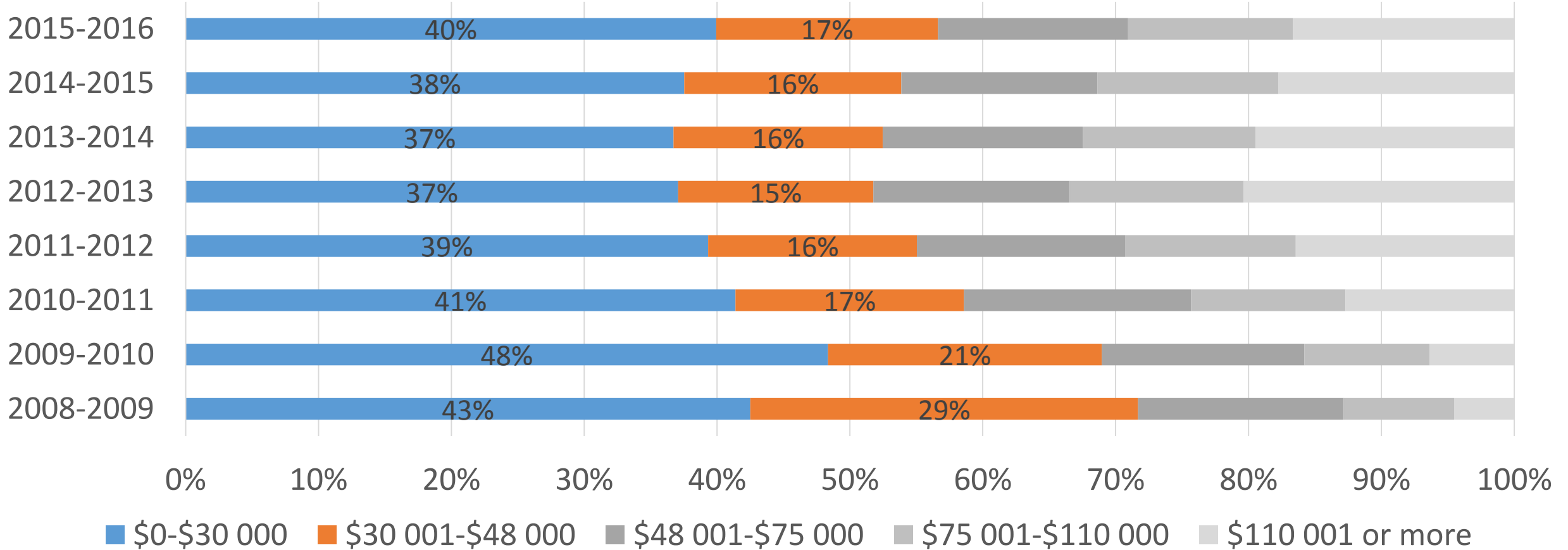

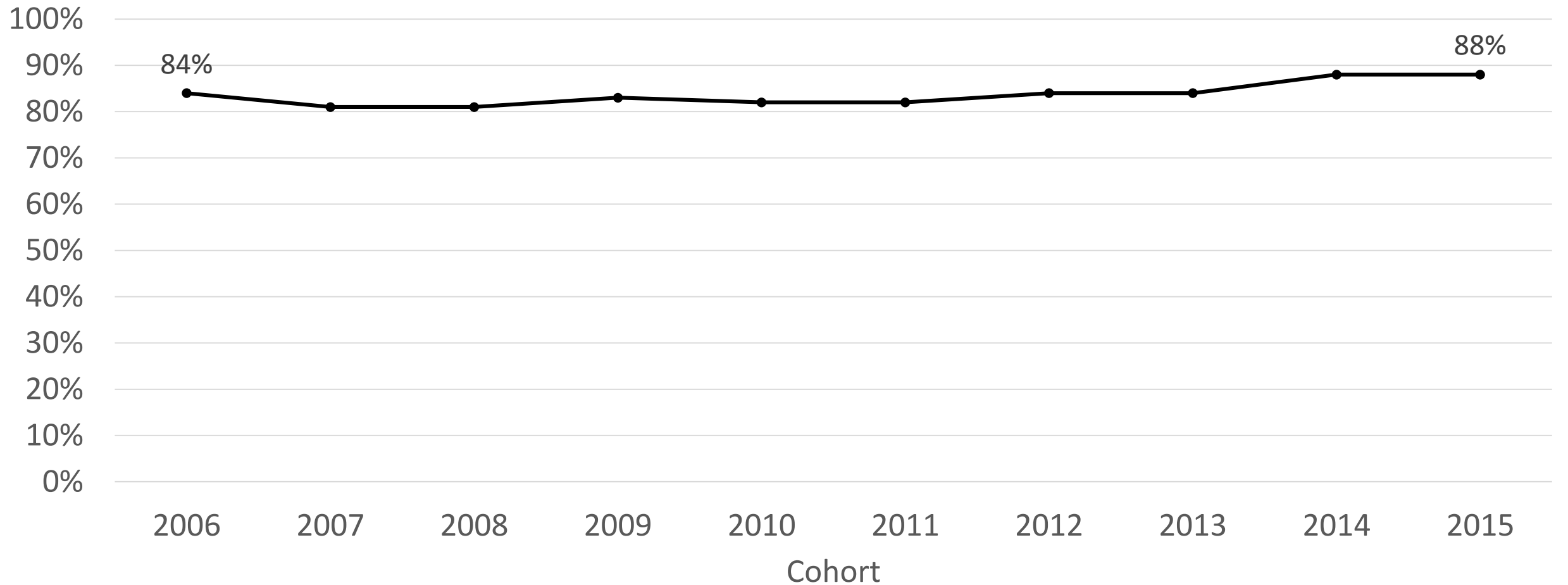
Percent of Full-time, First-time Degree-seeking Undergraduates who were awarded Title IV Federal Student Aid by Income Level



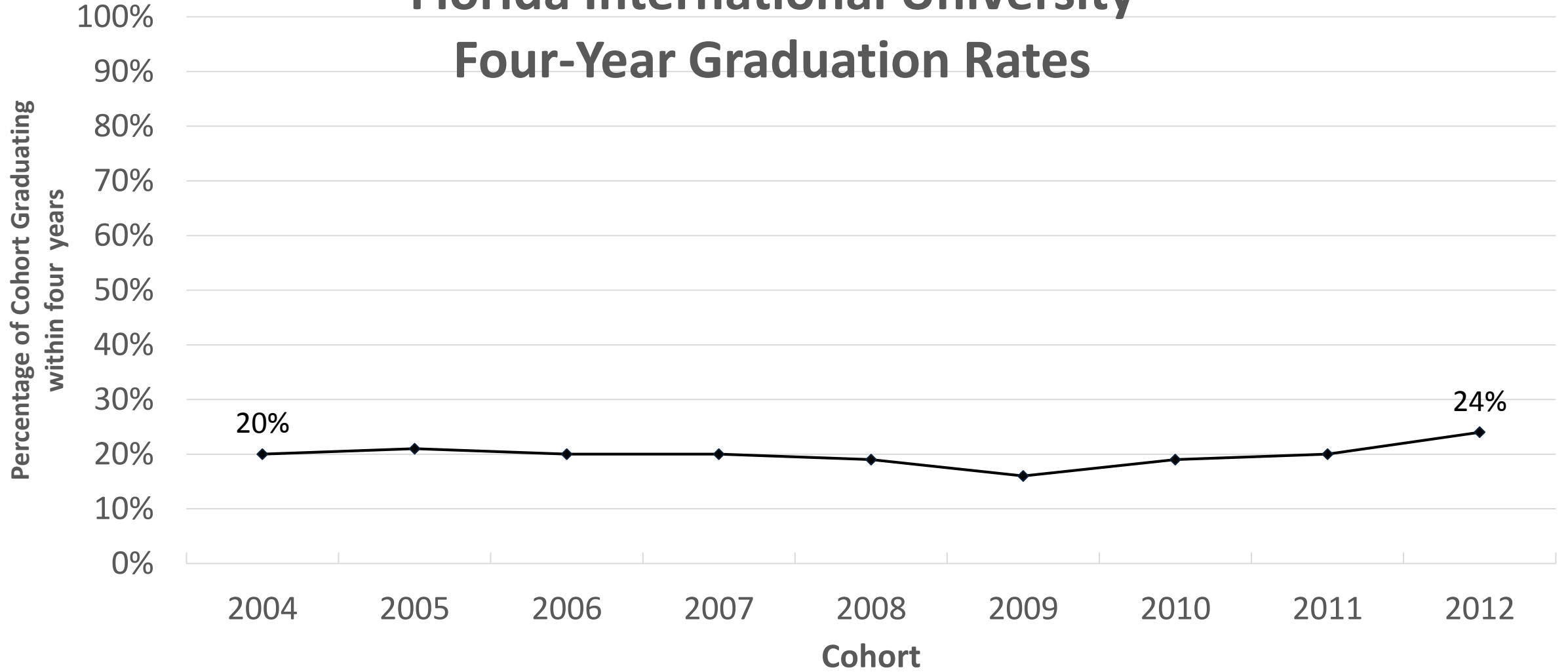

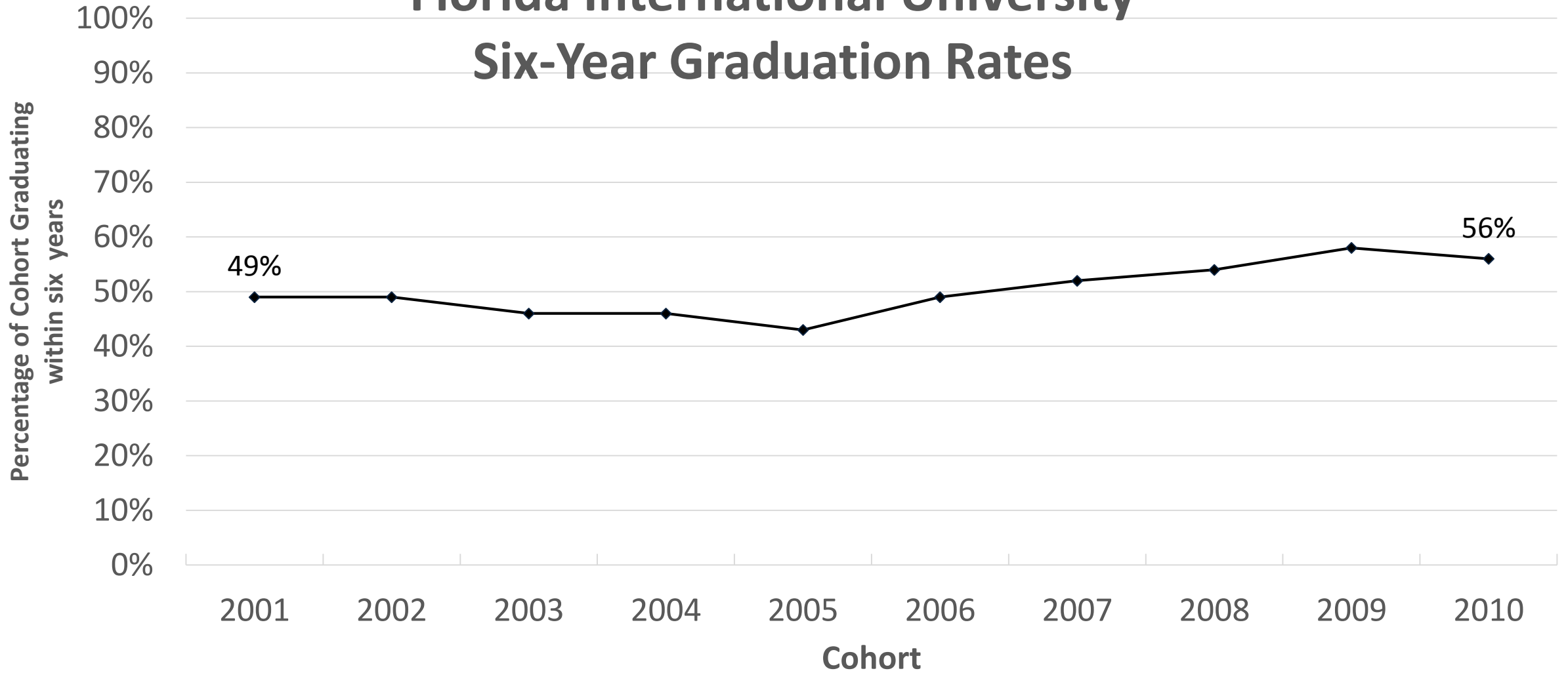
Florida International University One-year Retention Rates



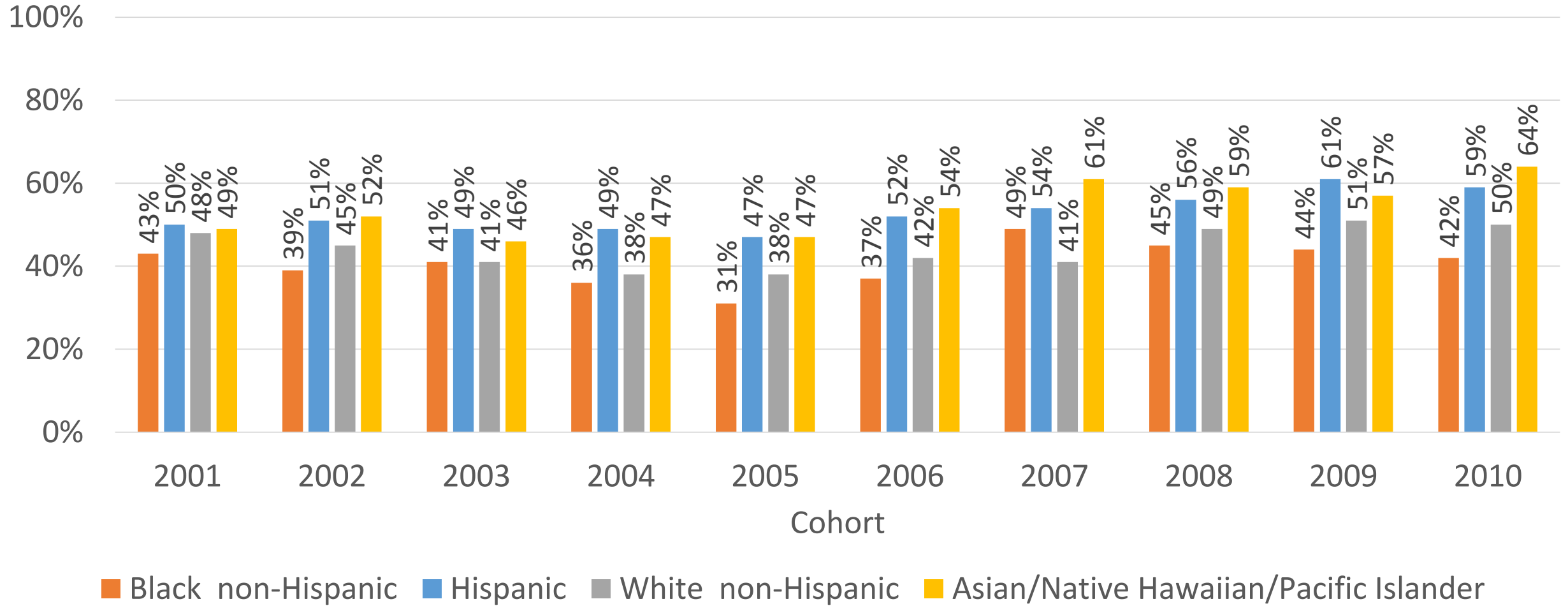
Florida International University Four-Year Graduation Rates



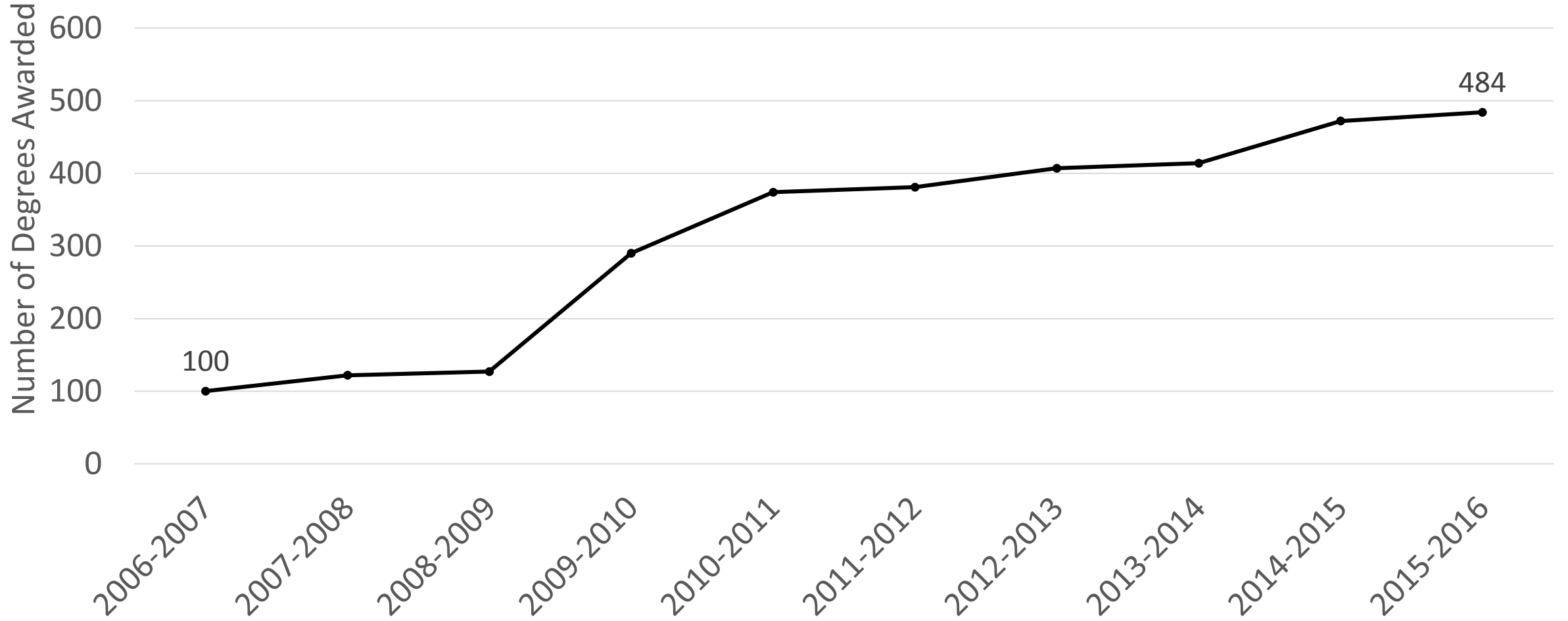
Florida International University Six-Year Graduation Rates



Florida International University Six-Year Graduation Rates By Ethnicity



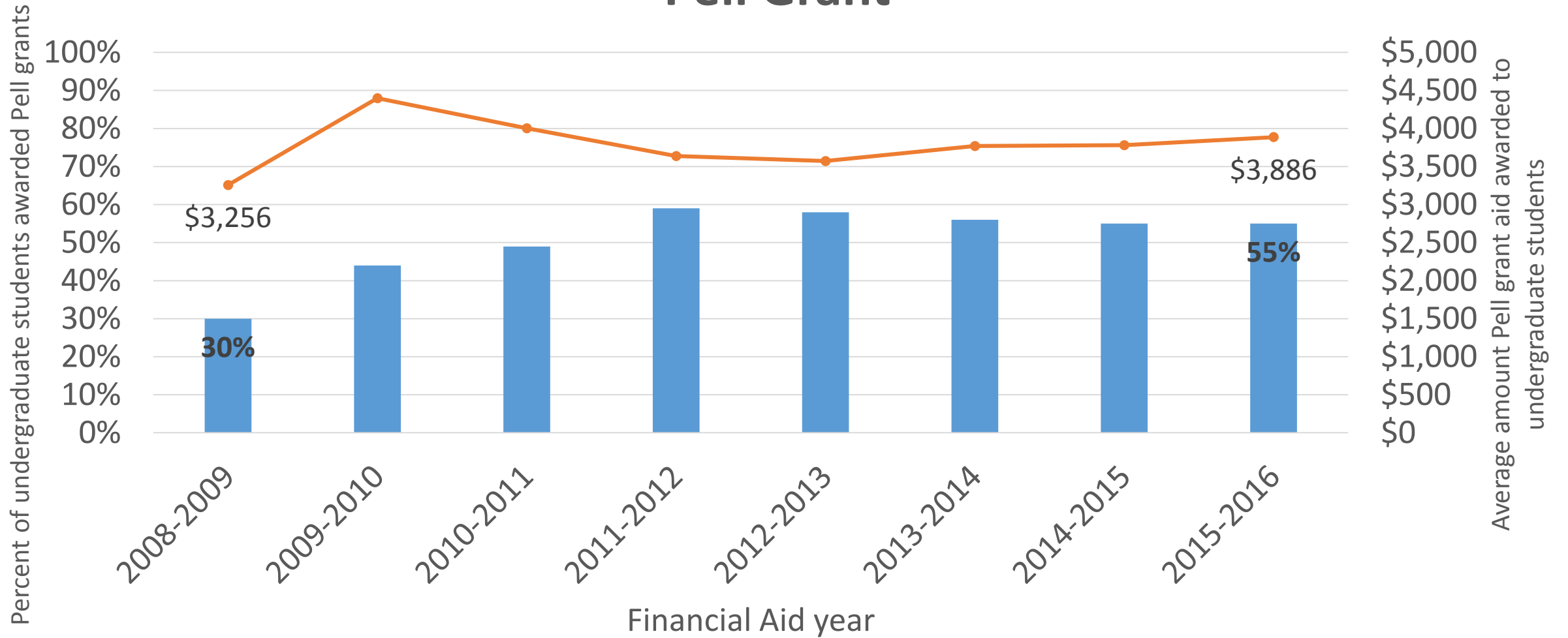

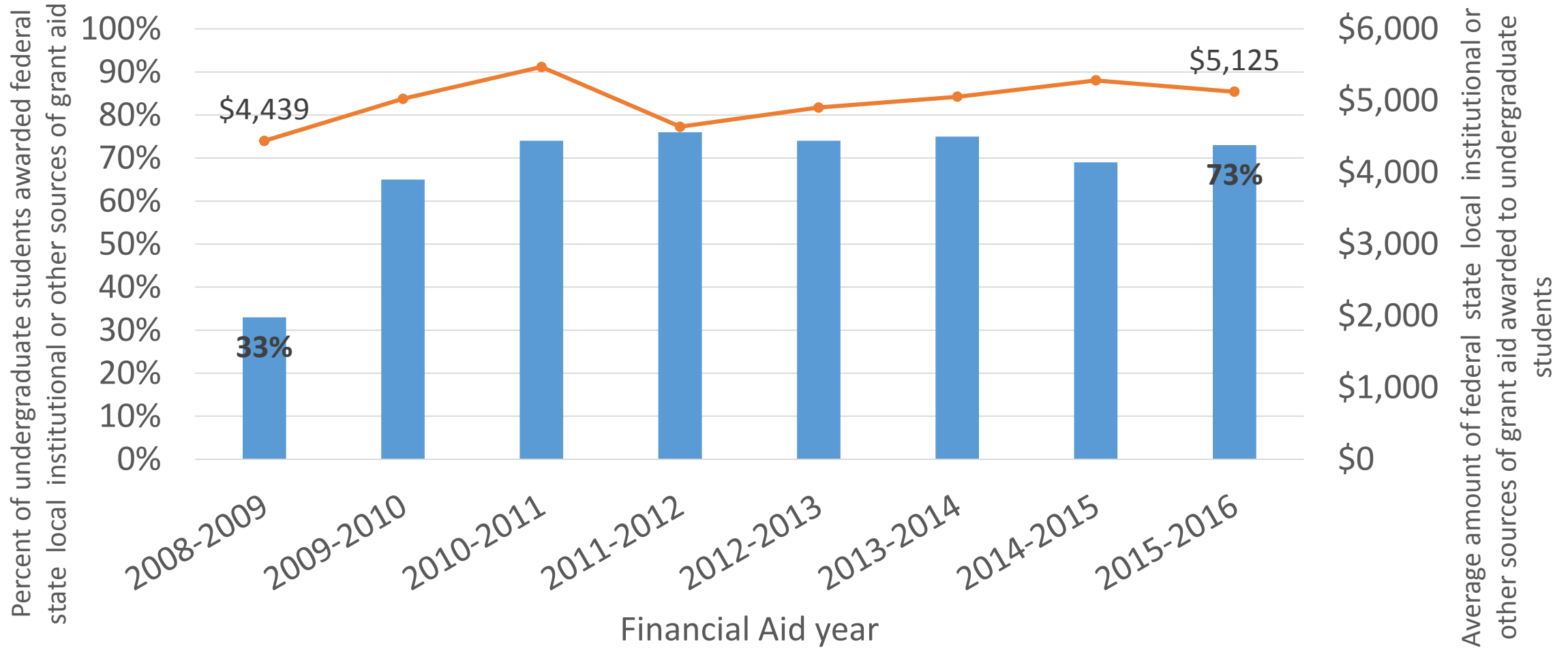

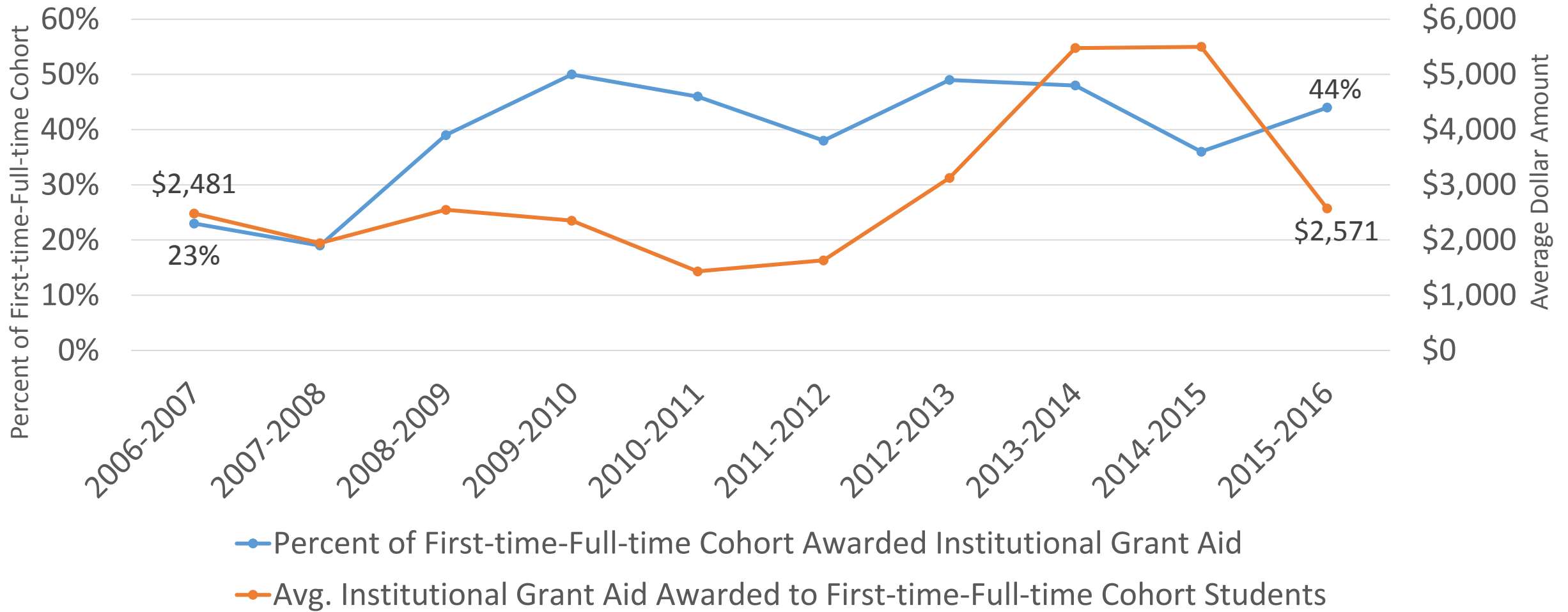

Florida International University Grant Aid All Sources



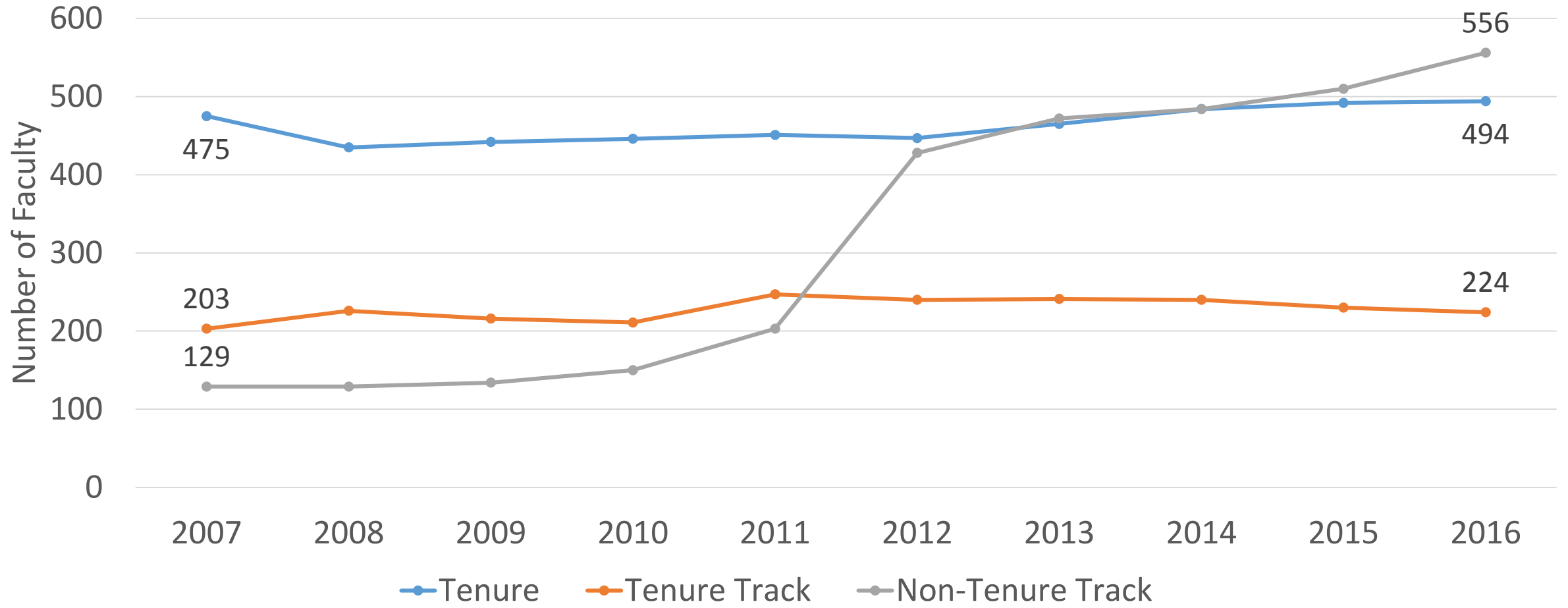

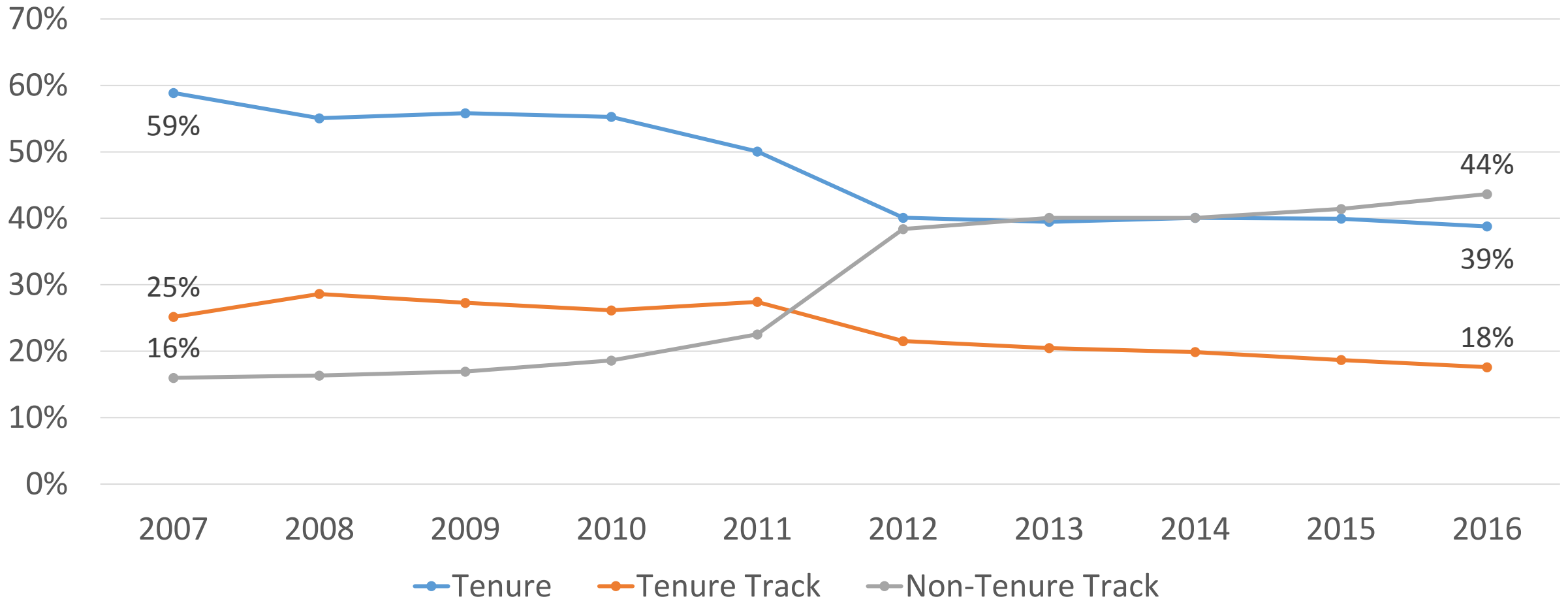

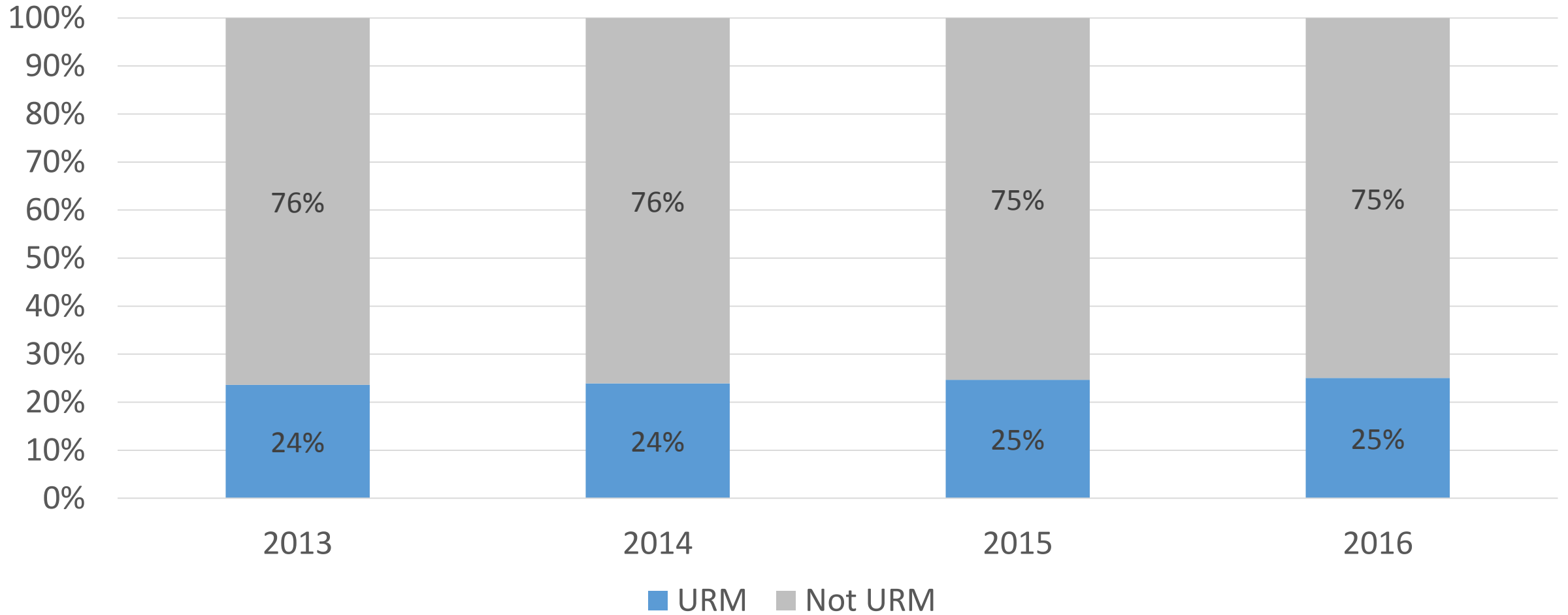
Florida International University Headcount by Tenure Status



Florida International University Percent of Faculty by Tenure Status

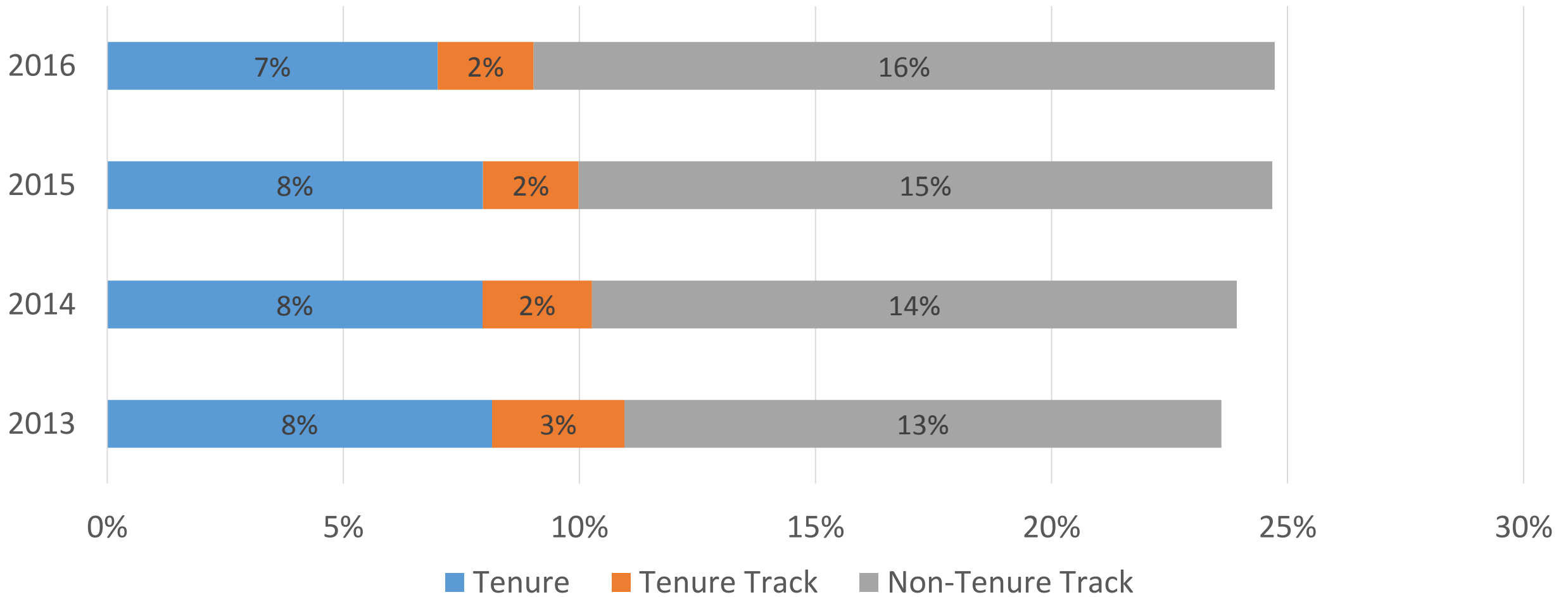

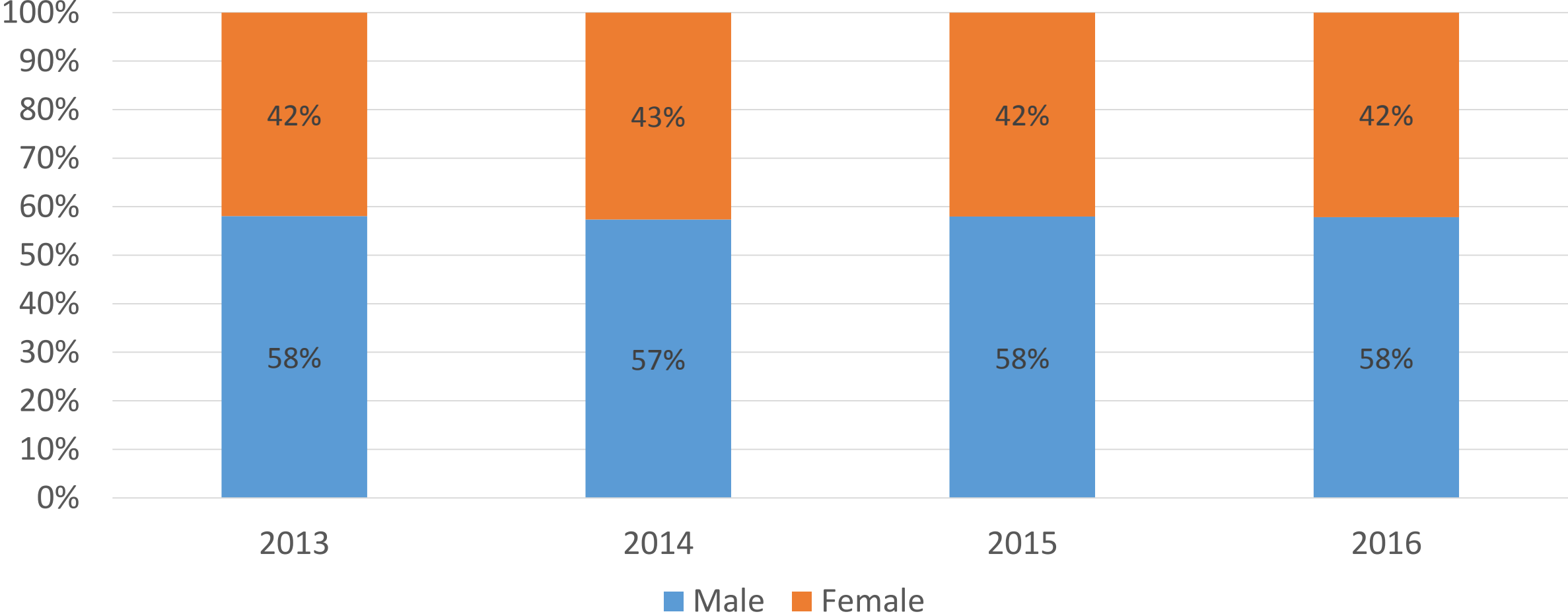

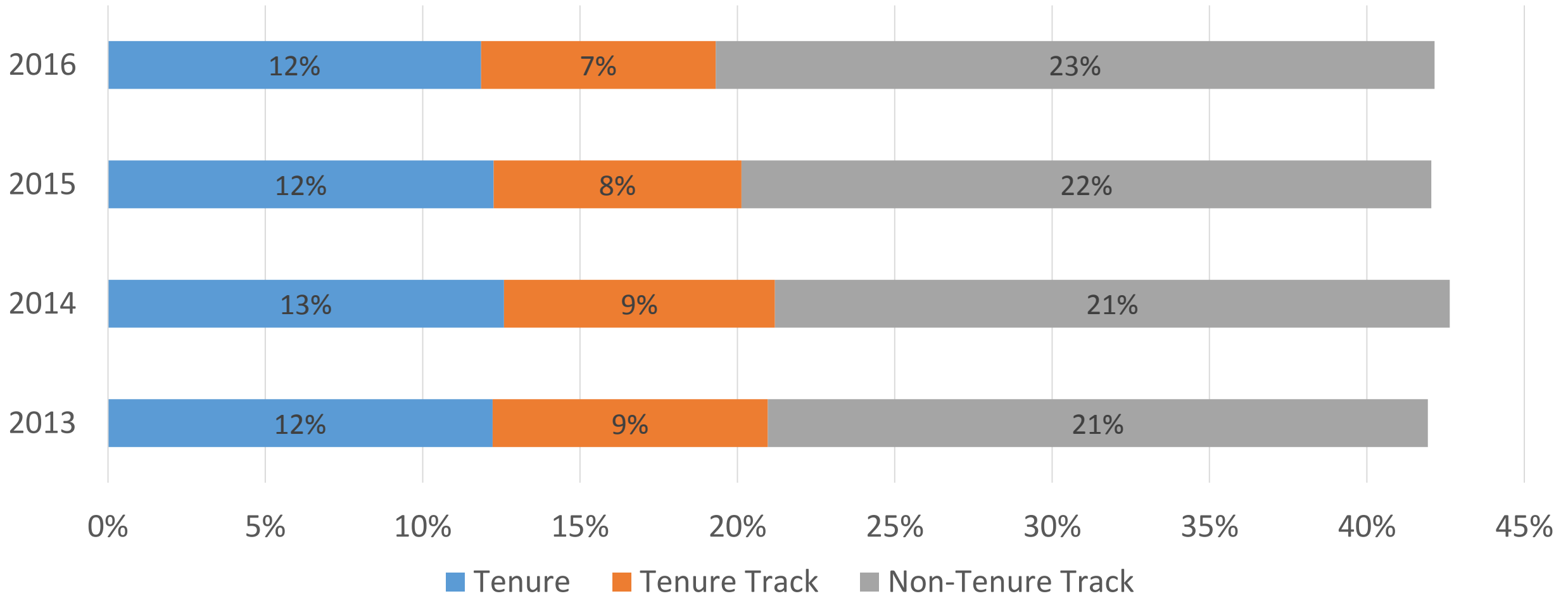
Under-represented Minority Faculty by Tenure Status



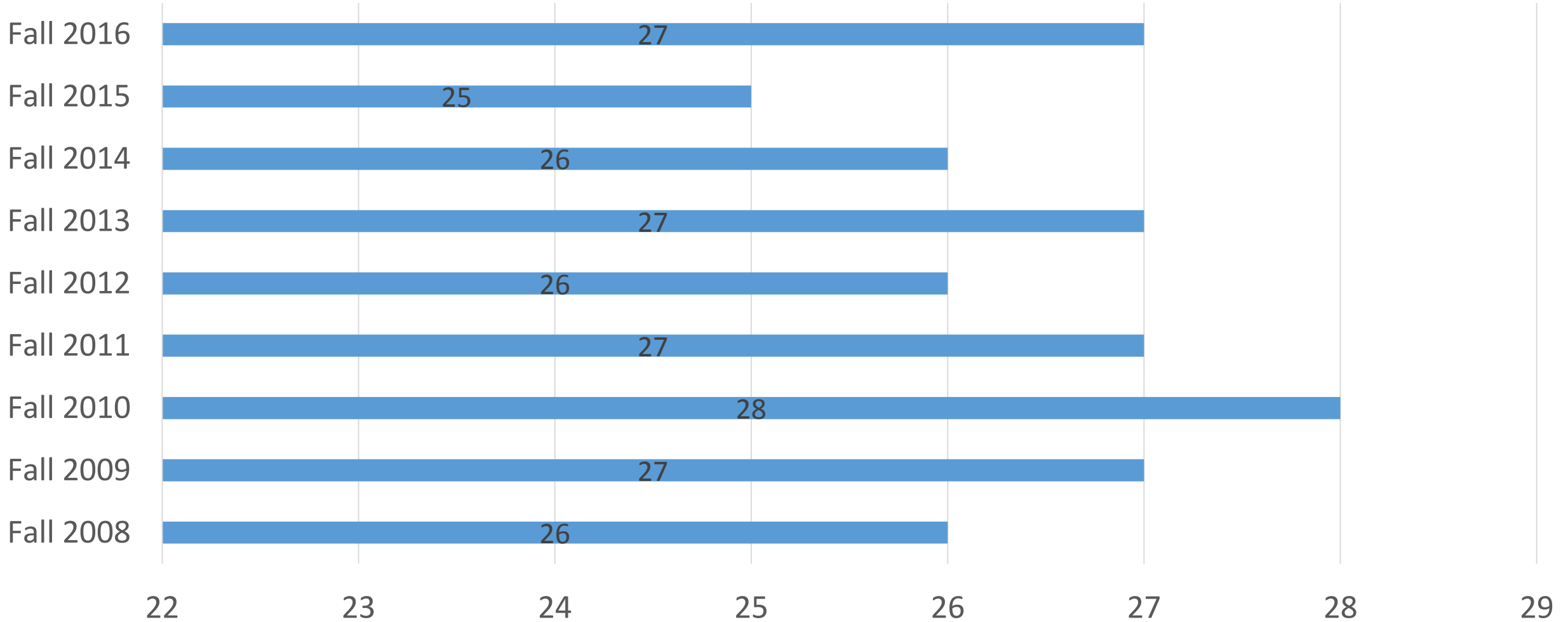
Florida International University Faculty by Gender



Florida International University Female Faculty by Tenure Status



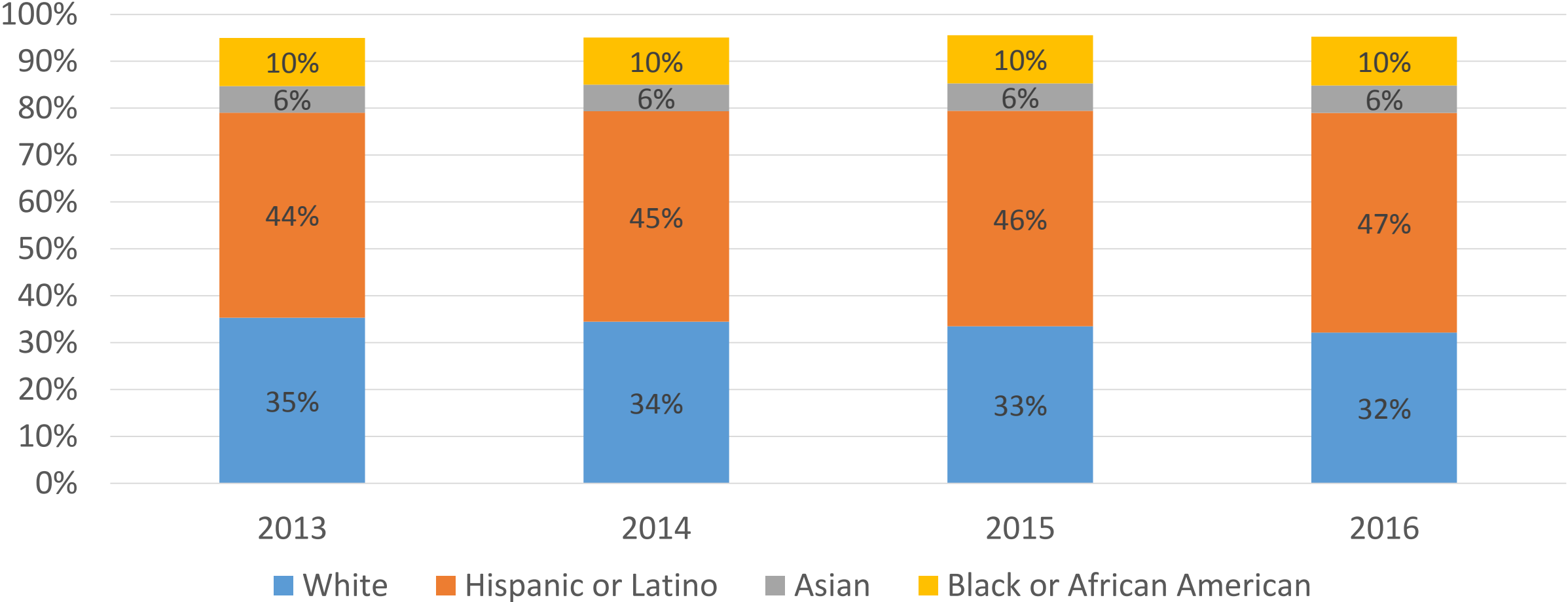
Florida International University Student-to-Faculty Ratio



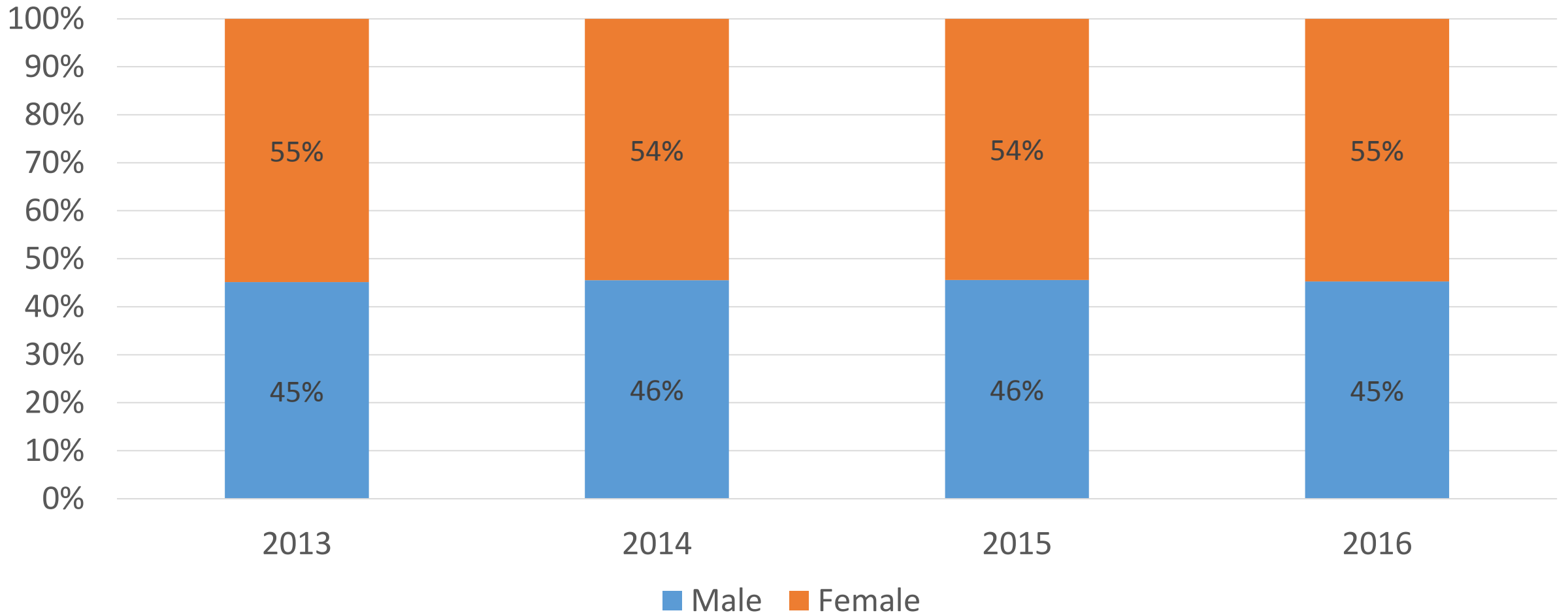

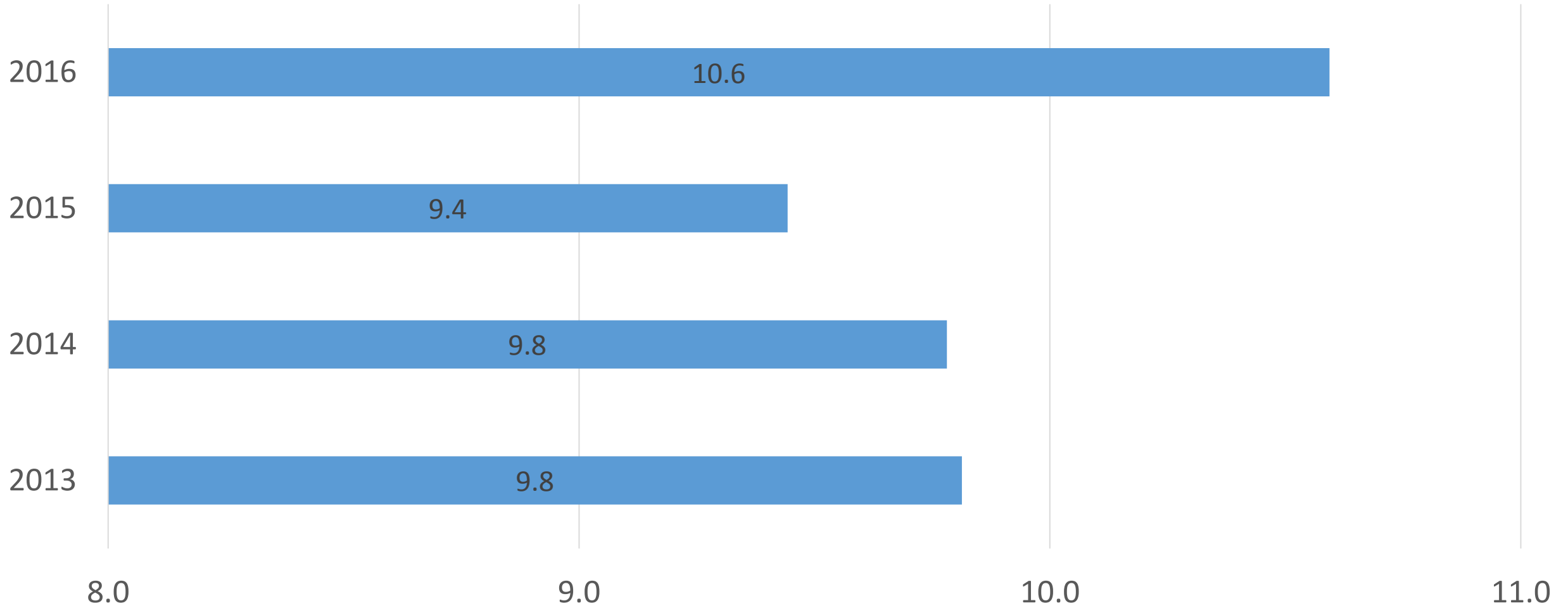
Florida International University Staff by Ethnicity

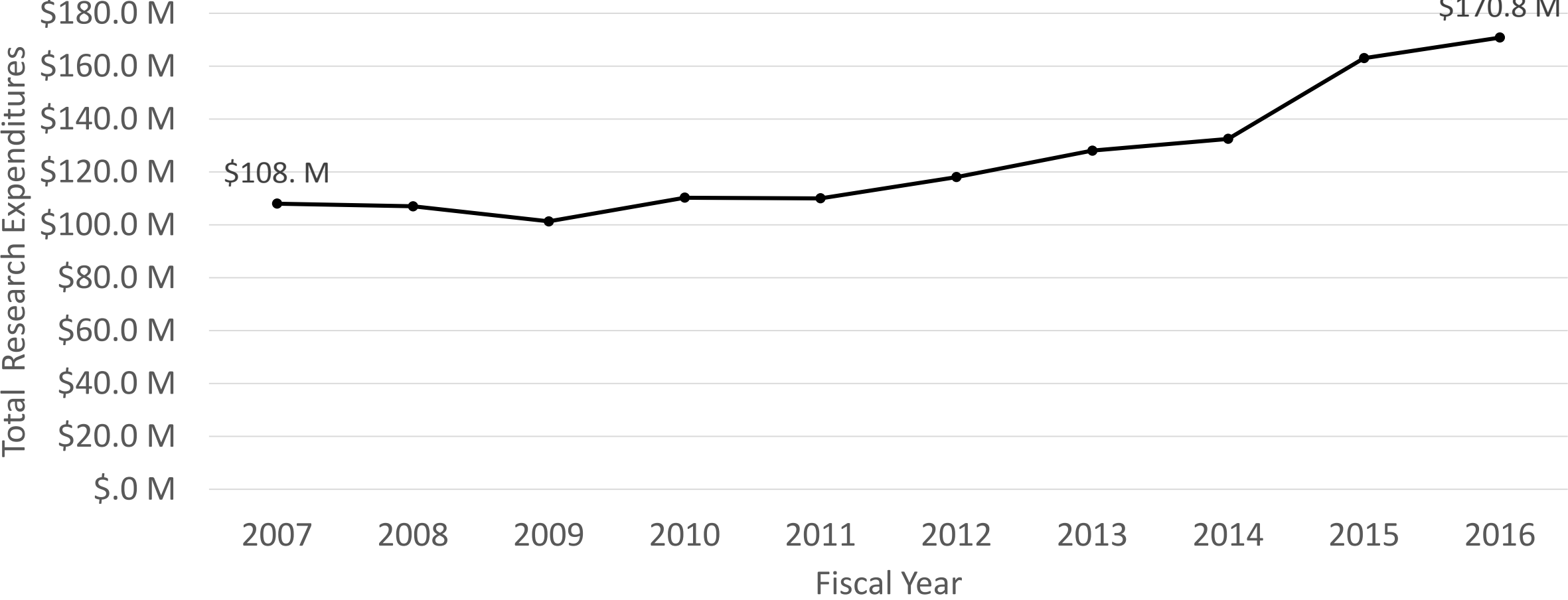

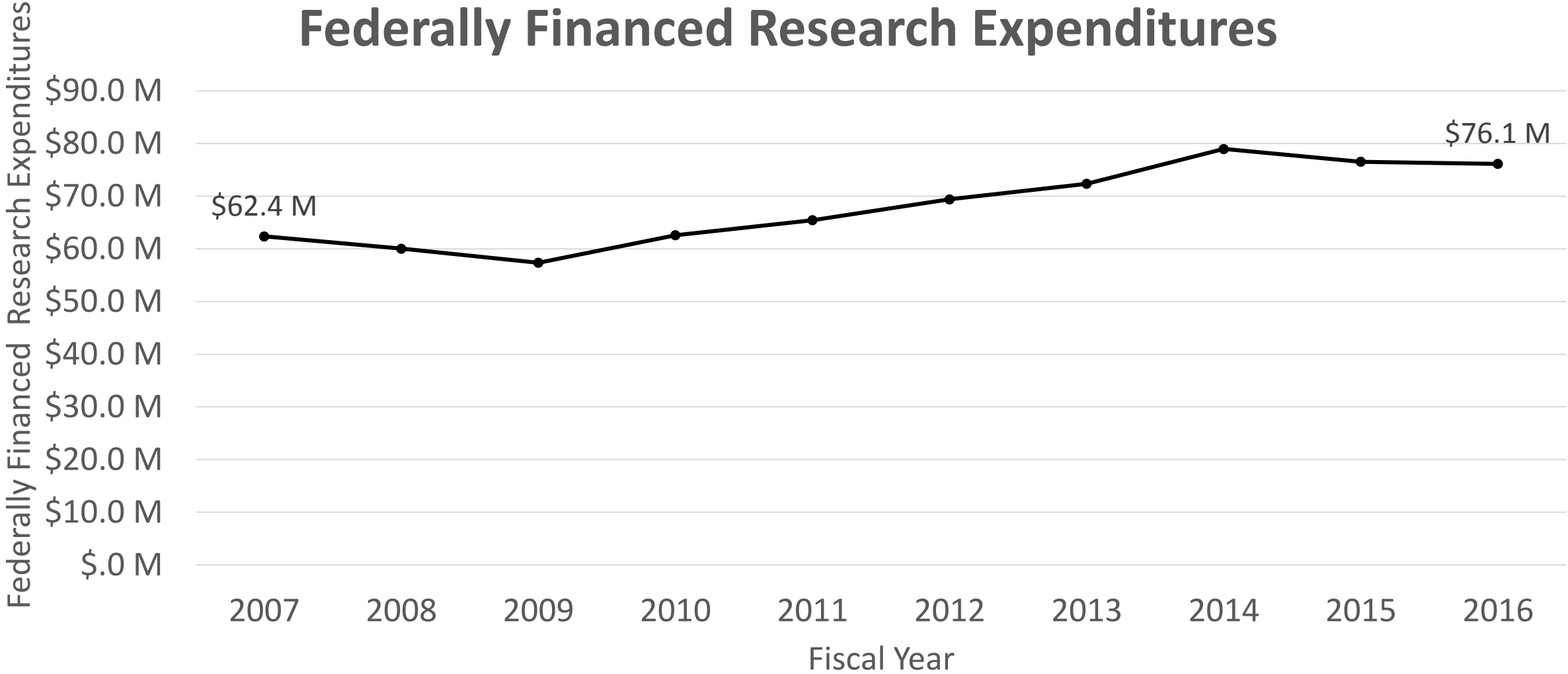


Florida International University Total Research Expenditures

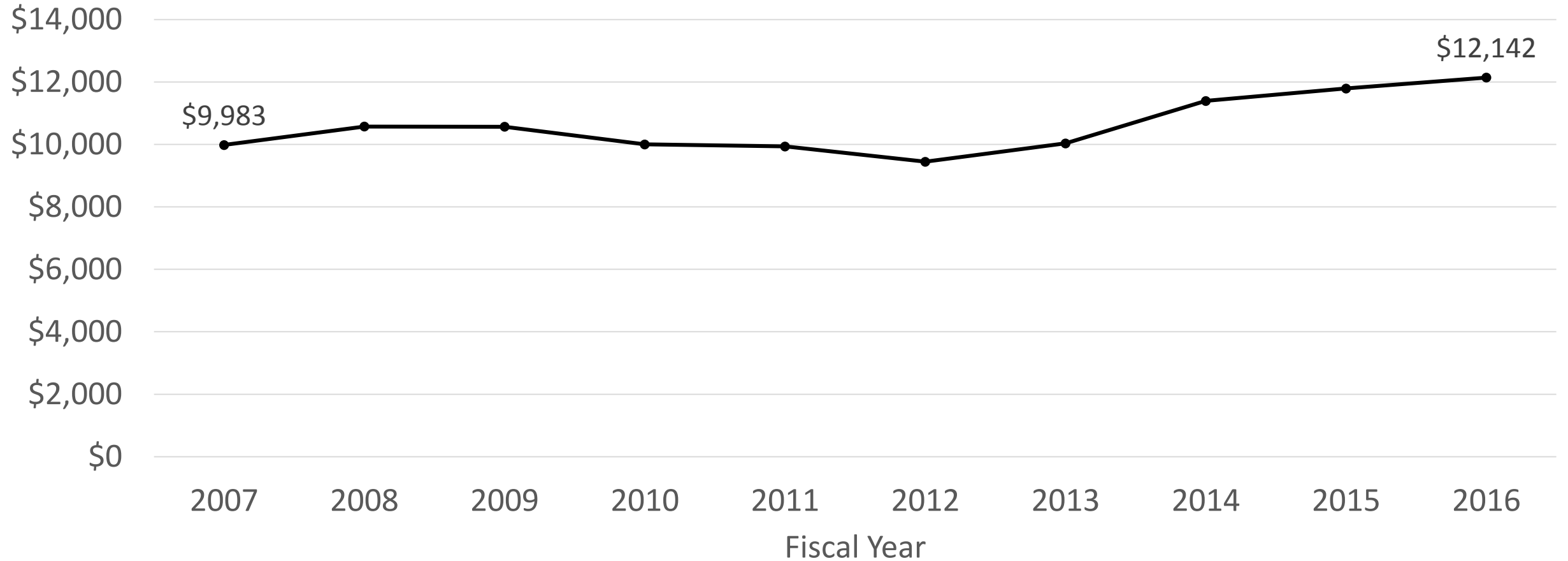

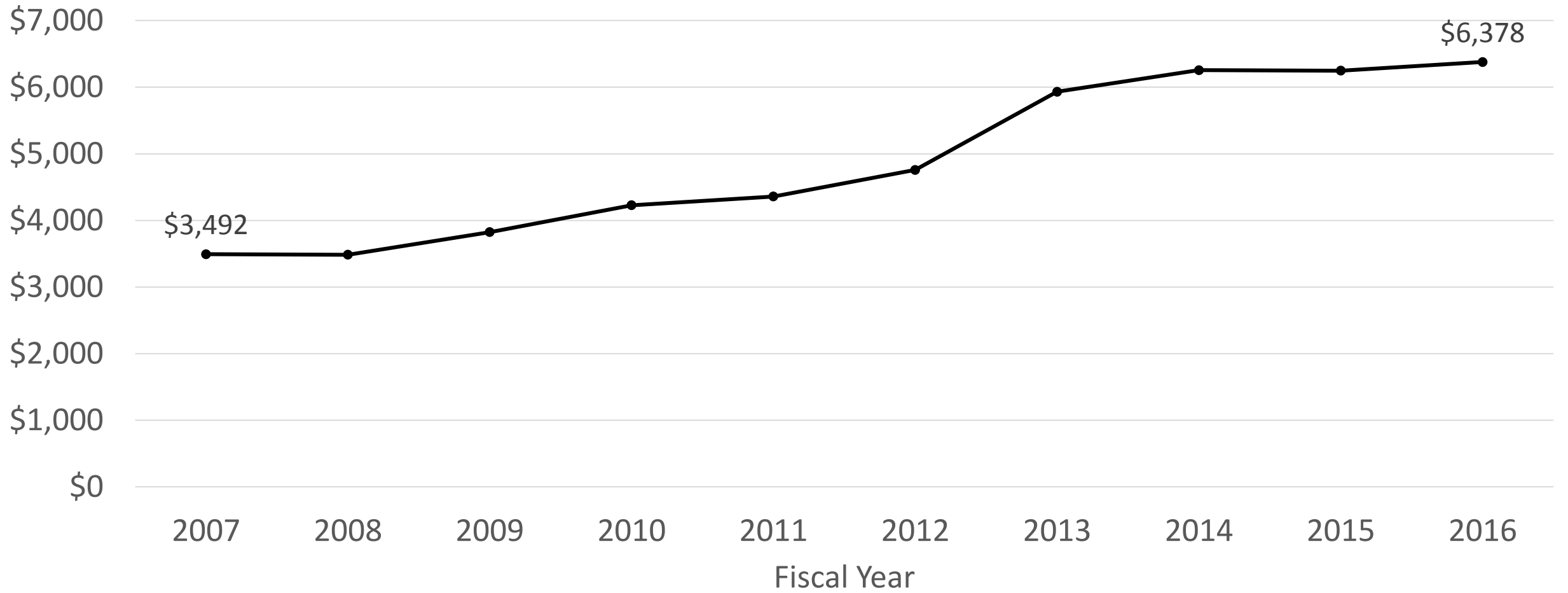

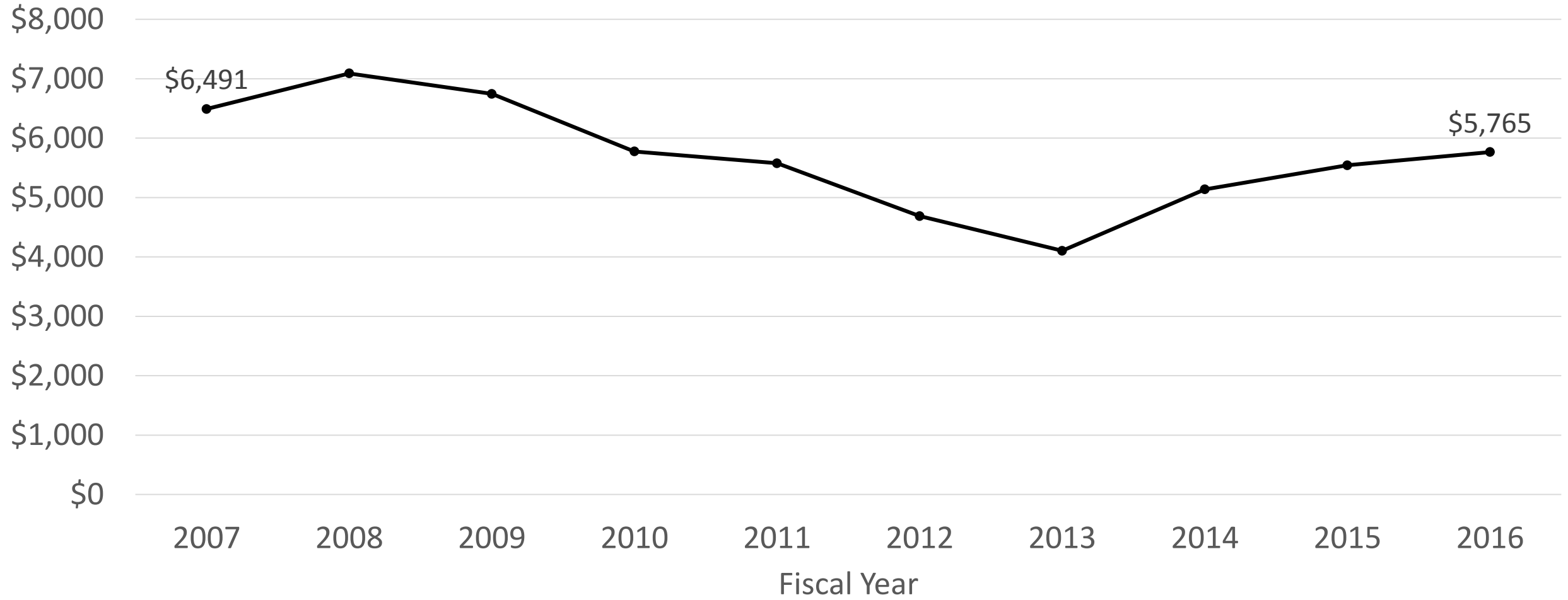
Florida International University Total Revenue per FTE Student



Florida International University Tuition and fees per FTE Student

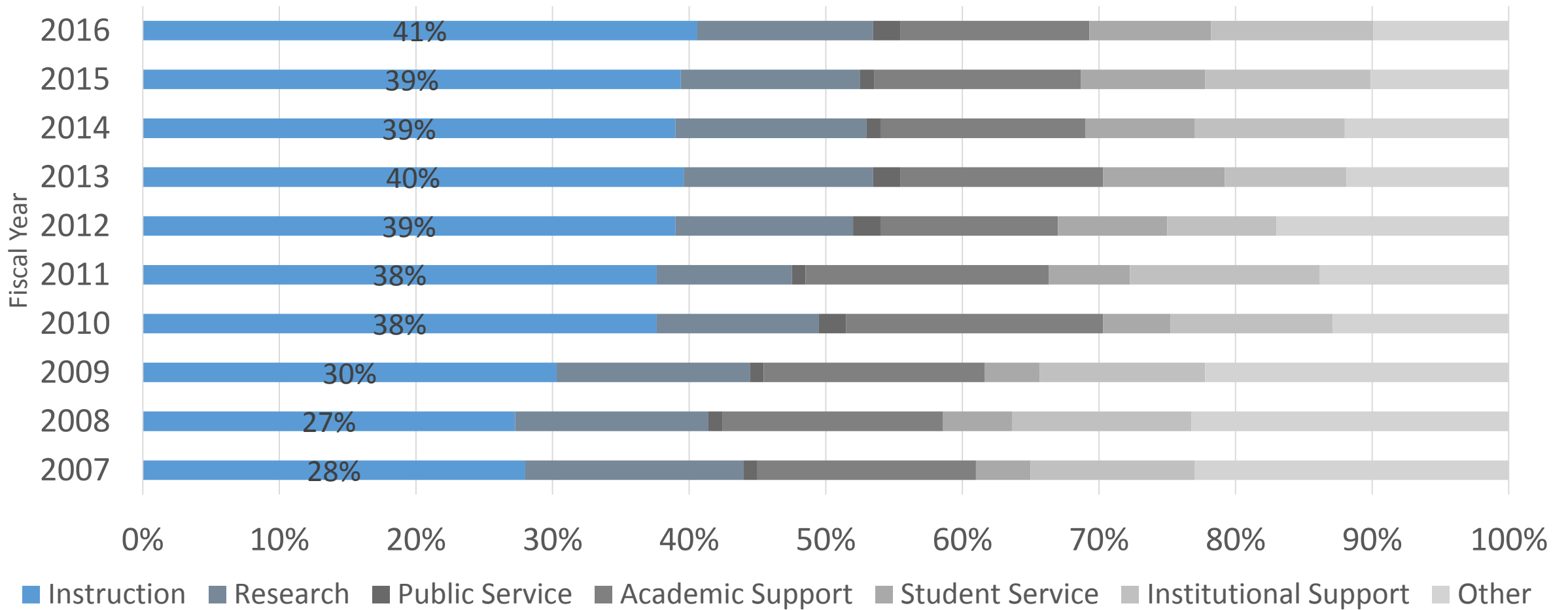


Florida International University State Appropriations per FTE Student



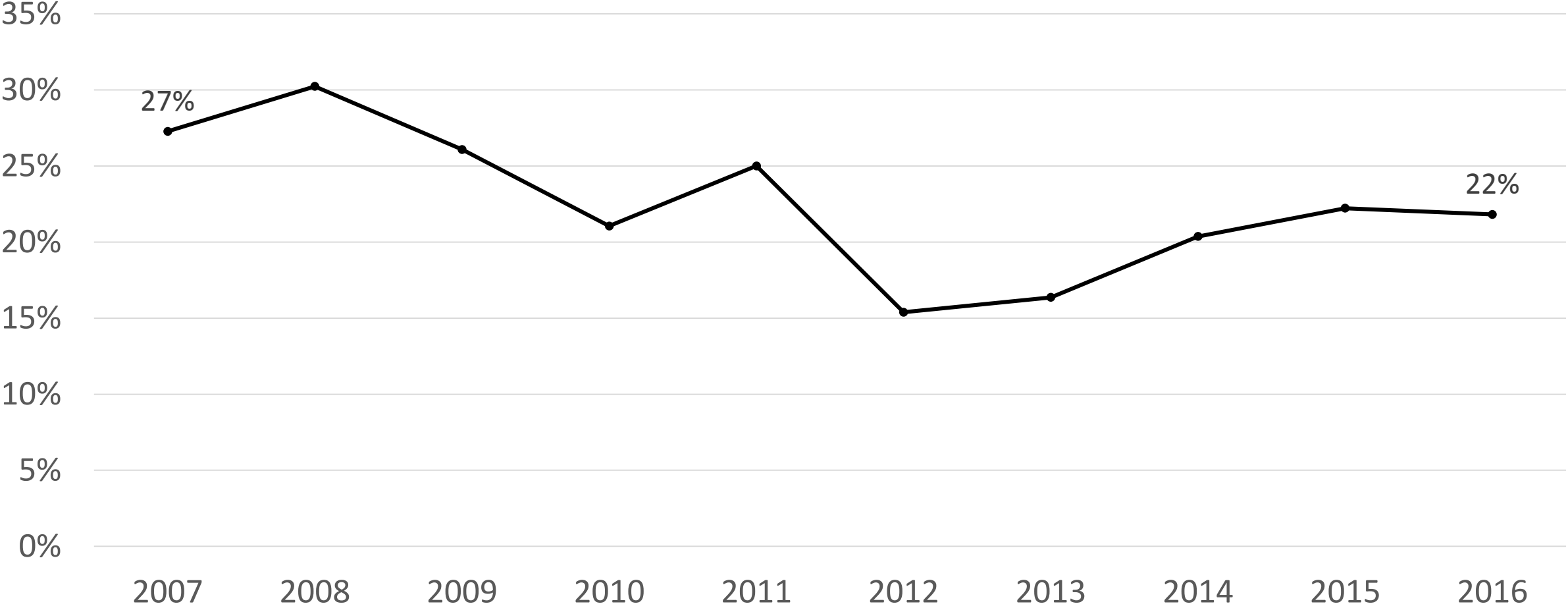

Administrative Cost as a Percent of Instructional Cost

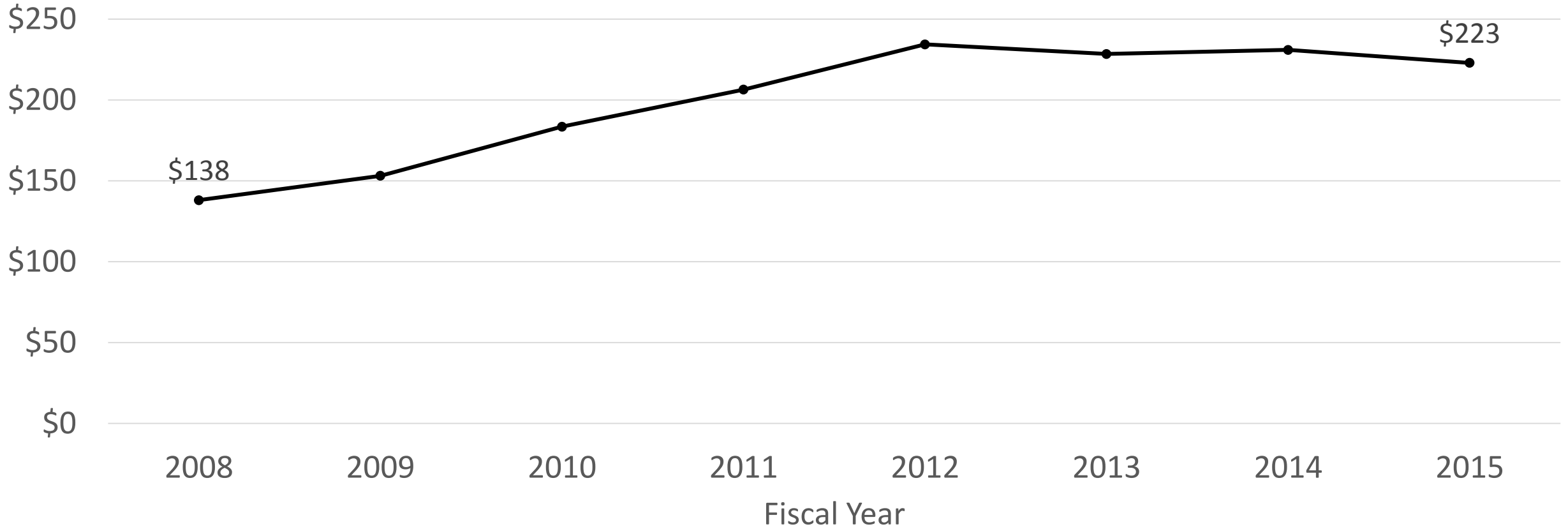
