

#### Introduction

The Athletics Master Plan scope included an evaluation of programmatic and space needs for all fifteen UTSA intercollegiate sports, including competition venues, practice fields, administration offices, and supporting student athlete development spaces. Beginning in the summer of 2018 as a part of the campus master planning process led by Page, DLR Group and Page assessed options for the configuration and siting of facilities to accommodate growth and future development. The Main Campus and Park West Campus were evaluated as potential locations for these facilities.

The primary goals for the Athletics Master Plan were to create an athletic-oriented experience for campus constituents, alumni, and fans; increase operational efficiency; and provide adequate facilities to support the current and future needs of each sport. Through the planning process with UTSA, it was determined that this could be best achieved through developing replacement facilities in a consolidated way on the Main Campus. The new Athletics District will be located in the southwestern quadrant of the Main Campus and will be structured around an extension of the existing Paseo network. This will create a navigable hierarchy of spaces and promote walkability between the athletics and the rest of the campus as well as in between facilities.

During the development of this plan, a separate design team was programming and designing two new athletics facilities, the Roadrunner Athletics Center of Excellence (RACE) and a new Park West team building. The first phase of the RACE building will be located on Rattlesnake Hill and will include coach and administrative offices, football training facilities, student athlete academic resources, sports medicine, weight room, equipment room, indoor football practice field, and outdoor practice field. The second phase will include another outdoor practice field and a basketball and volleyball practice facility. The Park West team building will be located adjacent to the existing stadium at the Park West Campus and will replace the offices, lockers, and other uses currently housed in temporary buildings.

#### **Existing Facilities**

The master plan team of Page and DLR Group toured all the existing athletic facilities at the University of Texas San Antonio during the kick off meetings. UTSA athletics and facilities staff were present on the tours in July of 2018.

During the tours, athletic coaches were made available to the design team for an open discussion. The discussion included:

- Current facility conditions
- Location
- Maintenance
- UTSA and NCAA criteria
- Operational needs
- Competition and practice needs
- Programmatic needs
- Fan amenities
- Other University needs

The information discussed was documented with notes and photographs, and then extrapolated into programmatic square footage needs.

The following photos illustrate the current physical conditions of the various athletic venues and support buildings. The general overall assessment of the UTSA athletic facilities concluded that the current facilities were not consistent with current comparable facilities in Division 1 athletics, and are past their life-expectancy for being acceptable athletic performance facilities. Athletic facilities for Soccer, Golf, Track & Cross-Country are temporary structures. The UTSA athletic training facility is a temporary structure that lacks many of the modern amenities for current training methods. Current facilities do not reflect a quality foundation for the sports teams to grow and meet competitive expectations.


























































































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


Hybrid - Park West Campus Revised V2 \*\*


#### **Alternative Concepts**


After the initial analysis, the team developed an athletics facility program and several alternative concepts to test configurations of the proposed facilities. These schemes explored options that would consolidate all facilities on the Main Campus as well as options that would split facilities between the Main Campus and Park West Campus. Through discussion with the athletics and facilities staff, the team determined that all facilities should be consolidated on the Main Campus, while the existing functions at the Park West Campus would remain in place. After iteratively evaluating optimal hierarchy and proximity between facilities, gameday event functionality, training schedules, operations, and fan experiences of the alternatives, the team selected the preferred alternative and final plan configuration.





Baseball Stadium



The UTSA baseball stadium remains in the current on campus location, and will be expanded to 1,500 permanent seats. A new enlarged press box with dedicated radio, broadcast, and writing press areas will replace the current facility. Adjacent to the press box will be an elevated hospitality area that could have suites, loge boxes, or a club depending on the demand. All new fan amenities will be located on the concourse. The baseball team will have new batting and pitching cages down the left field line. New team facilities will be located across Barshop Rd. A plaza will connect the new tennis facility, softball stadium and the expanded baseball stadium which will provide a location for branding and donor opportunities.





A new enlarged press box will feature dedicated radio, broadcast, and writing press areas. Adjacent to the press box will be an elevated hospitality area that could have suites, loge boxes, or a club depending on the demand. All new fan amenities will be located on the concourse. The softball team will have new batting and pitching cages down the left field line. New team facilities will be located in the outfield. A plaza will connect the new tennis facility, baseball stadium and the relocated softball stadium which will provide an location for branding and donor opportunities.

The new UTSA tennis complex will feature 12 outdoor courts and 6 indoor courts. Both the outdoor and indoor courts have an elevated walkway with dedicated spectator seating. The outdoor courts have 600 seats and the indoor courts have 500 seats. The new tennis complex will have a direct connection to the new plaza that connects the baseball and softball stadiums. Roadrunner tennis teams will have new locker rooms and lounges. Equipment and laundry will be handled within the team building to create efficiency. The open lobby could be a Hall of Fame space for tennis displaying trophies, memorabilia, graphics, and branding. The exterior of the team building will match the architecture of both stadiums to create a unified style and create locations for branding and donor opportunities.





Athletics Master Plan Multipurpose Arena



The new 10,000 seat arena provides the UTSA campus with a new on-site home to the Roadrunner's basketball / volleyball programs as well as hosting large on-campus events such as graduation. Amenities within the building include Locker rooms for men and women sports, premium seating options, Club Space and open concourses with concessions and restrooms. The main entrance to the Arena faces the corner of Barshop Rd and the Paseo Principal where visibility and pedestrian access from on and off-campus can be navigated with ease. Complimenting the entry is a plaza located just off the existing Paseo Principal and further extends the footprint of the campus towards the southwest to accommodate for future growth.







The Park West Track Stadium expansion will increase seating capacity to 10,000 with additional restrooms and concessions to support the fans. Maintenance and grounds facilities will be added to create a self-sustaining Park West Campus. The New Park West Team Building will provide Roadrunner Soccer and Track & Field all the necessary amenities the teams need to elevate their programs within close proximity to their sports fields. The Park West Team Building was designed concurrently with this study, so the final layout and program are not included in this report.
