


Eduroam Connection Instructions for iOS devices

(for visitors to UTSA from UTHSCSA)

3. Select **eduroam** from the list of available networks.

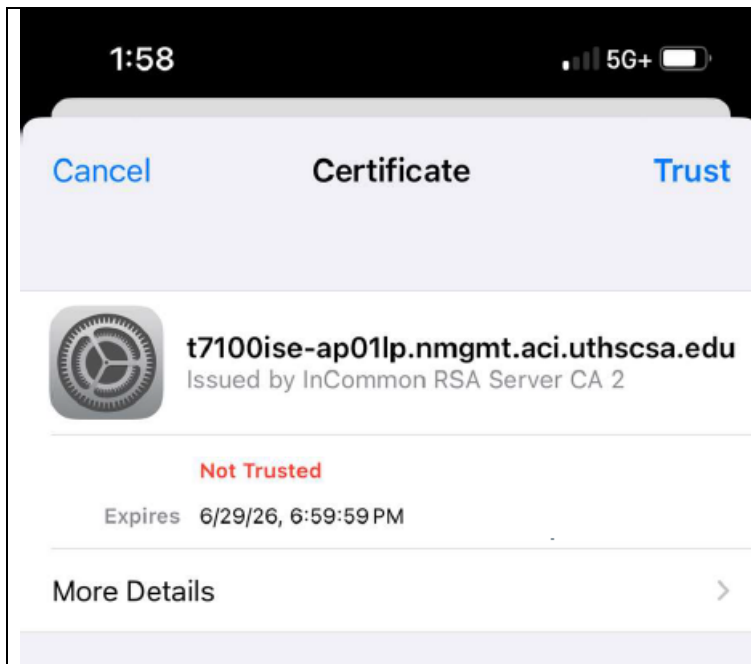
