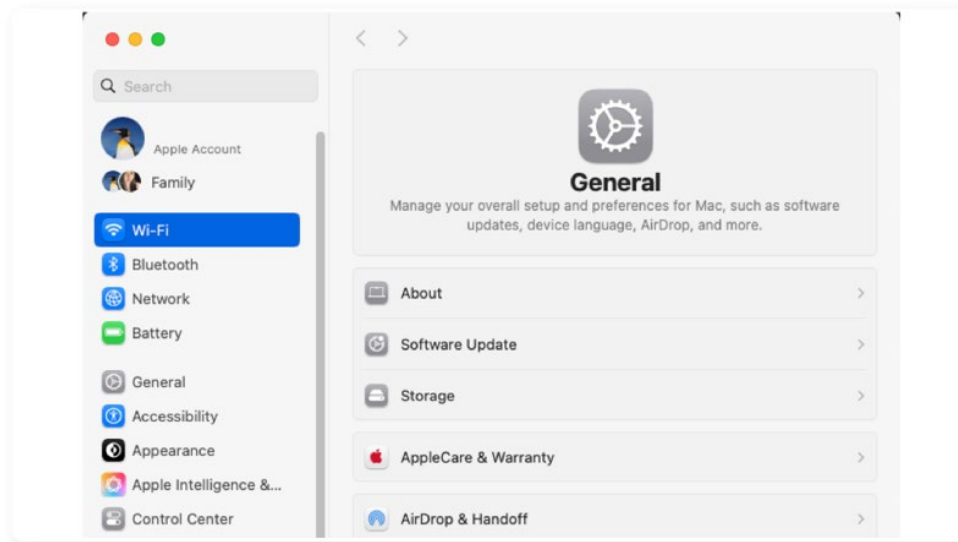
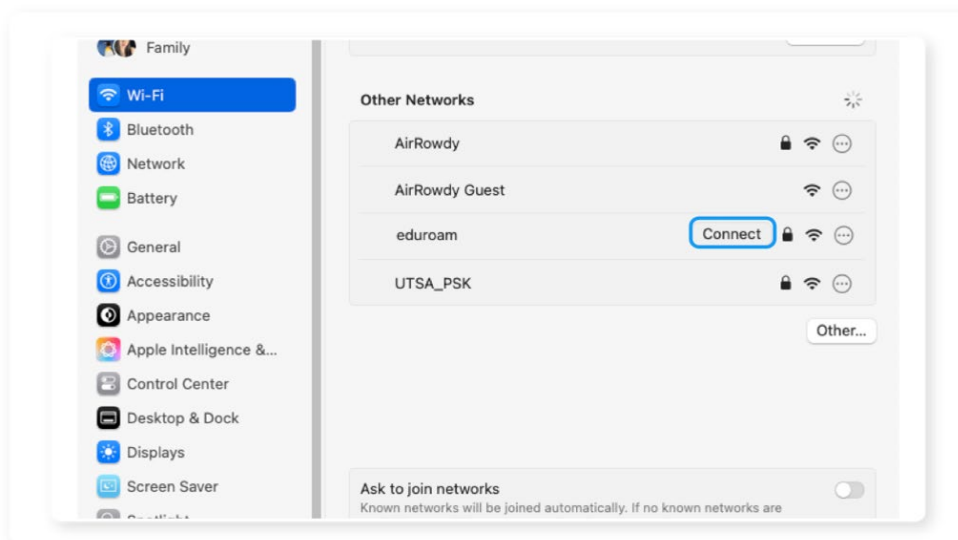


Connecting to Eduroam for MacOS


- 1
 - Go to **System Settings**
 - Click on "**Wi-Fi**"

 - Search for "**eduroam**"
 - Then click on "**Connect**"




- 3 Enter your **University email account credentials**, then select **"OK"**
