To improve and streamline your technology experience, University Technology Solutions (UTS) will migrate all student email accounts from Google Workspace to Office 365 on October 4, 2021.

- New Email Address Format—On October 4, you will be issued a new email address comprising of your <u>first.lastname@my.utsa.edu</u>. After October 4, any emails sent to your previous <u>abc123@my.utsa.edu</u> email address will be automatically redirected to your new inbox. While the automatic redirect will help prevent your mail from getting lost, we do strongly encourage you to update or change your email address anywhere you're currently using your abc123@my.utsa.edu email.
- Gmail will become Read Only— No data from your Google Workspace will be deleted as a result of this migration; however, your Gmail email will become read-only as of October 4. No new email will be able to be sent or received to your Gmail inbox. You will be responsible for transferring any relevant data from your Google Suite at your convenience. Detailed instructions and assistance in transferring that data will be offered when your new inbox is launched.

 No More Preferred Email Address — Once the migration is complete, students will no longer be able to designate a <u>preferred external email address</u> with which to conduct University business.
