


Enabling your laptop for EduroamView your list of wireless networks: Click on the bars in the lower right of the desktop:




Open "Network and Sharing Center."




Click on "Manage wireless networks."




Click on "Add."




Click on "Manually Create a network profile."



Enter the information above in each field and click "next."




Click on "Change connection Settings."



Click on the "Security" tab."




Then click on the "Settings" button.




Click on the "Configure" button.




Uncheck the automatically use my Windows logon box and click "OK."




Click on the "OK" button in this screen:




Click on "Advanced settings" button.




Check the box “Specify authentication mode” and select “User or computer authentication”
