#### **CONNECTION AND VISIBILITY**

- » The Roadrunner Athletics Center of Excellence (RACE) symbolizes а transformative moment for UTSA, creating a new centralized resource for studentathletes to help them achieve athletic and academic success.
- » UTSA Athletics is the front porch of the university and now has a prominent home situated on over 10 acres off the Paseo, UTSA's main artery in the heart of campus.
- » With Athletics administration previously off campus and student support services spread across campus, student-athletes can now easily find and access the resources they need.
- » RACE gives UTSA student-athletes the opportunity to optimize every minute of their day, allowing them to make the most of their time training and studying in the pursuit of excellence.

#### **ELITE ATHLETE TRAINING**

- » The facility's efficient design allowed for focus to be placed on the interior, which is extremely spacious to support a stateof-the-art training facility.
- includes practice fields, locker rooms, a sports medicine center, and strength and conditioning facilities.
- » RACE also offers academic study spaces, staff and coaches offices and meeting rooms.
- » Just as UTSA intends to be an exemplar in academics and research, RACE will have a long-lasting impact on the university's stature as a Division I competitor.
- » This elite training facility will make UTSA more competitive in recruiting and retaining the nation's best studentathletes and coaches.

#### **AUTHENTICALLY SAN ANTONIO**

- » RACE's exterior matches the typology of campus, creating a visual tie between this state-of-the-art facility and the history of UTSA.
